



Agreement of Biomedical Waste Management





Agreement

This agreement is entered into on February 29th 2024, by and between IIHMR University, represented by **Dr. Susheela Sharma, Chief Administrative Officer, IIHMR University, Jaipur** having its registered office at IIHMR University, Jaipur, 1, Prabhu Dayal Marg, Near, Sanganer Airport, Jaipur, Rajasthan 302029, hereinafter referred to as "University," and Eternal Hospital, Sanganer, represented by **Dr. Vrajesh Shah, Unit Head, Eternal Hospital, Sanganer, Jaipur** having its registered office at Eternal Hospital, Sanganer, Jaipur, Rajasthan, 302029 hereinafter referred to as "Hospital".

Background:

The University generates biomedical waste as part of its healthcare facility, academic and research activities, which necessitates safe and proper disposal to ensure environmental protection and public health. The Hospital possesses the requisite infrastructure and expertise for the collection and disposal of biomedical waste.

Purpose:

This agreement aims to establish a framework for the collection and disposal of biomedical waste generated at the University by the Hospital, in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

Terms and Conditions:

Scope of Services: The Hospital agrees to provide comprehensive services for the treatment, and disposal of biomedical waste generated at the University premises.

Responsibilities of IIHMR University:

- The University shall segregate biomedical waste at the point of generation according to the color-coded waste segregation guidelines.
- The University shall ensure the proper storage of segregated biomedical waste in designated areas until transportation to the Hospital.
- The University shall be responsible for the transportation of the biomedical waste on weekly basis at the registered office of the Hospital.

Responsibilities of Eternal Hospital:

- The Hospital shall transport the collected biomedical waste to its facility for treatment and disposal through environmentally safe methods.

Non-Financial Obligation: There shall be no financial obligations on both the parties under this agreement. This agreement is based on spirit of cooperation and to make the above-mentioned registered office of the university bio medical waste hazard free.

Compliance with Regulations: Both the parties shall comply with all applicable laws, regulations, and guidelines related to the handling, transportation, treatment, and disposal of biomedical waste.

Confidentiality: Both parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of any sensitive information shared during this agreement.

Duration: This agreement shall be valid for a period of two year(s) from the date of signing of this agreement, renewable upon mutual agreement between the parties.

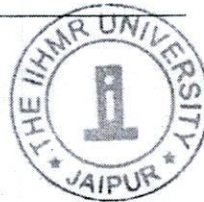
Governing Law: This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Jaipur, Rajasthan.
