Course Description:

Design is basic to all human activity. It is the underlying matrix of life. The regenerative ecological design cycle of nature that sustains the web of life with its inter and intra relationships and intricate patterning is nature's supreme design.

Cultural evolution of human societies can be seen as an informal, collective, generational process of design. With the transition to industrial societies design emerged as the 'science of the artificial' complementary to natural sciences. This is the interface of applied knowledge and professional action. Artificial refers to man-made and is a product of art/technique presupposing different levels of technological integration ranging from optimizing industrial production to frontiers of AI and Robotics, the 'post biotic world'.

Humans have always learnt from nature in terms of compassion, creativity, collaboration and communication. Frugal embeddedness forms the core of adaptability and resilience of most human societies in preindustrial times. The planning and patterning of any action towards a desired, foreseeable end constitutes the design process. Design is conscious effort to impose meaningful order. Everyone designs who devises courses of action aimed at changing existing situations into preferred ones. The intellectual activity that produces material artifacts is no different fundamentally from the one that prescribes remedies for a sick patient or the one that devises a new sales plan for a company or a social welfare policy for a state.

Design thinking refers to a creative process that is multi-dimensional, iterative and human-centered involving five phases—Empathize, Define, Ideate, Prototype and Test that have considerable overlaps. This basic core of the design process originating in manufacturing products for modern industrial society, planning built environments and architecture, is being used as problem-solving framework well-suited to address complex, dynamic and persisting problems relating to organization processes, managing business, services and processes and the goals of sustainable development as in the SDG agenda for 2030. .

Design thinking appears to be a possible approach to address this multi-faceted, multi-layered and complex goal, where achieving triple bottom line (TBL) are markers of progress in the right direction.

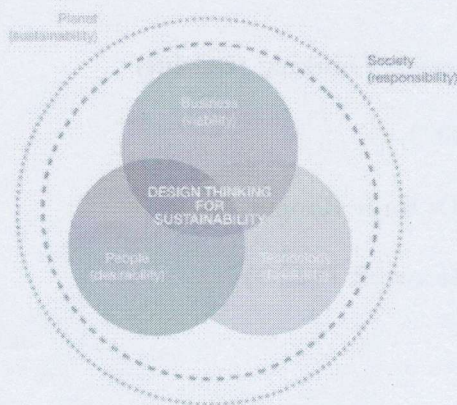

Looked at in this vein, this course on Design Thinking (DT) aims to acquaint its participants who are going to be professionals in the health, hospital, pharma and development sectors. DT is primarily an approach to thinking systematically to resolve wicked problems having multiple dimensions such as sustainability, responsibility, viability, desirability, feasibility etc.

The course using an empathetic approach to meet unmet social needs provides four levels of learning: 1. *Artefactual* – replication of similar design 2. *Analogic* – metaphor to inspire 3. *Heuristic* – models of thinking 4. *Gestalt* – configuration of

factors. The design approaches discussed in this course are of various types such as inclusive design (Design that destroys inertia and enhance inclusion), rejuvenating design (Design that repurposes skills, resources and institutions), disruptive and embedded design (Design that redefines the context, so that content changes), gratitude and empathetic design (Design that recalibrates the moral compass), sufficiency design (Design that serves unmet social needs through new service models), circular & sustainability design (Design that make us sensitive to the needs of future generation) and insular design (Designs that make us indifferent to the needs of others). In inclusive innovation, spaces, sectors, seasons, social segments and skills & knowledge are the dimensions of inclusion.

The ongoing unfolding of the CORONA pandemic reminds us that we live in a habitat where it is necessary to respect the relationship between animal, social life, and the environment to survive and thrive. With COVID19 pandemic, nature is sending us a message that we need to recognize the interrelationship and coexistence in nature. Rural industrialization and dispersed urban growth are going to be prominent features for private capital and state policy regulation. This is going to have an immense impact on calibrating businesses, their articulation and adoption of sustainable processes in domains of human resource management, or organizational structures / processes, social and economic transformation.

In a context of 'living with COVID', economic recovery pathways are intimately linked to sustaining public health measures like sanitization, quarantine, isolation, physical social distancing that are as of now our best foot forward to combat corona at a mass level. Planning recovery interventions in rural, rurban and urban India would require a synergy between public health measures to contain the

epidemic as well as ensure economic recovery that gets redistributed in an equitable and sustainable manner.

In post COVID times such as the ones we are living through the course aims at igniting thinking and doing pathways for young professionals. Learning from nature helps in design of distributed knowledge management, which is accessible, available, adaptable, affordable, reliable and frugal. Creating open source public standards of excellence leads to a pool of knowledge that can help individuals expand their horizon of learning.

Course Objectives:

1. To initiate idea of design thinking as a creative problem solving process
2. To acquaint participant to application scenarios where this approach is applied to solve a wicked problem
3. To enable learning processes of design thinking for sustainability in diverse sectors in health, hospital, pharma and rural development

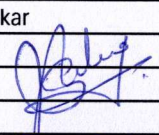
