Force Majeure, Impediments

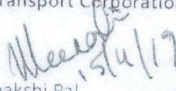
1. The Vendor suffering the event of force majeure shall not be deemed to be in breach of this agreement or otherwise liable to the other party for any delay in performance or any non-performance of any obligations under this agreement (and the time for performance shall be extended accordingly) if and to the extent that the delay or non-performance is due to an event of force majeure.
2. If the event of force majeure in Question prevails for a continuous period in excess of 3 months after the date on which it began, the other party may give notice to the party suffering the event of force majeure terminating this agreement.
3. The notice to terminate must specify the termination date, which must be not less than 30 clear days after the date on which the notice to termination is given.
4. Once a notice to terminate has been validly given, this agreement will initiate on the termination date set out in the notice.

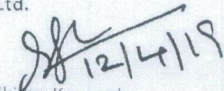
Arbitration Clause

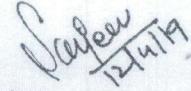

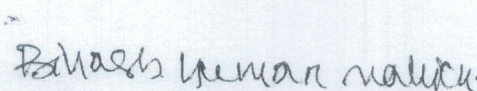
