Our Invention Preventing gender-based crimes, kidnapping, and rape of girls and women is a Sexual violence is a major problem faced by women and girls in India. It is already a challenge for survivors to obtain justice in the Indian legal system, and those from the country's marginalized communities face even more major barriers. There were 32,033 reported rape cases in 2019, with 33,356 in 2018. According to official crime data, there were 3,486 reported cases of rape against Dalit (Scheduled Caste) women and girls in 2019, and 1,110 reported rape cases against Adivasi women and girls (Scheduled Tribes). Survivors of sexual violence face huge barriers in accessing justice, including community pressure to drop the case, discriminatory attitudes of police and judicial officers, insufficient legal aid, and discouraging conviction rates. These challenges are often magnified if the survivors are members of India's marginalized communities, particularly if they are Dalits, Adivasis, or Muslims. Rape is a highly gendered violent behavior where most of the sexually violent perpetrators are men, and most of their victims are women. Rape, the most common form of violence against women has been a part of human culture and is a profound violation of woman's bodily integrity and can be a form of torture. The subject of rape comprises more than the actual physical act as it involves many factors such as law and customs, social, and political events and so on. While the physical reality of rape has been unchanged over time and place, however, the perceptions, ideas, and laws about rape have changed.

Background: Quality Improvement (QI) is the organised approach to design and apply constant development in performance. QI in hospitals increase patient satisfaction, staff satisfaction as well as the quality of care provided by an organisation. In India quality of hospitals is assessed by different standards which primarily included those laid down by National Accreditation Board for Hospitals & Healthcare Providers (NABH), which were introduced in 2006 by Quality Council of India (QCI). In 2018, National Health Authority (NHA), introduced Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB - PMJAY) Quality Certification standards, in collaboration with Quality Council of India (QCI), for enhancing patient satisfaction and improving quality standards across the hospitals.

This study highlights the progress in health infrastructure, improvement in health-related indicators, initiatives taken for improvement in quality of health care services provided during 2014 to 2022. It also highlights the recommendations for improving the health infrastructure.

INTRODUCTION

One important measure of the quality of a person's life is his/her health condition. Like the other basic needs of food, shelter and education, health is a priority and a prerequisite for a happy life. It is a well-known truth that there is a connection between people's health and the nation's economic growth. 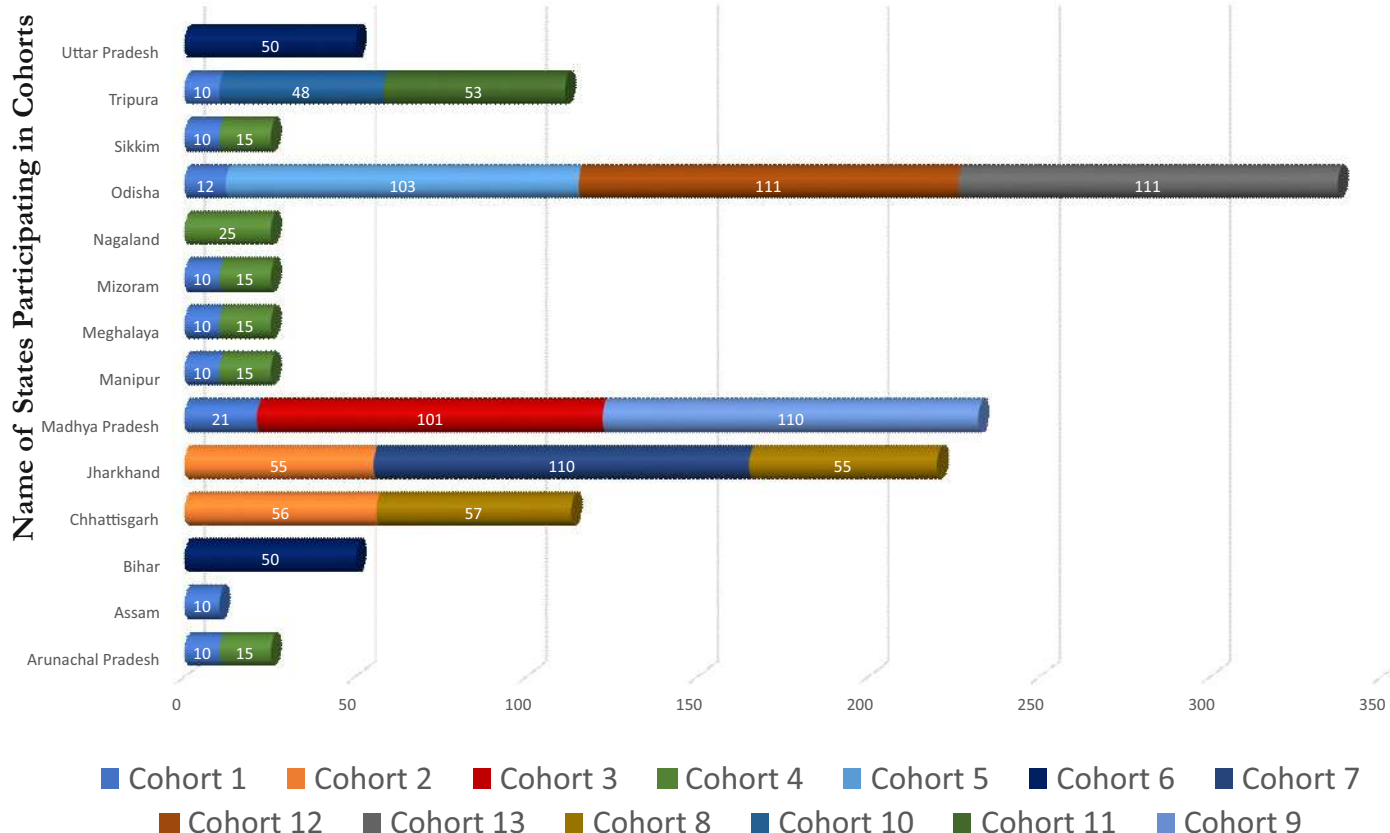

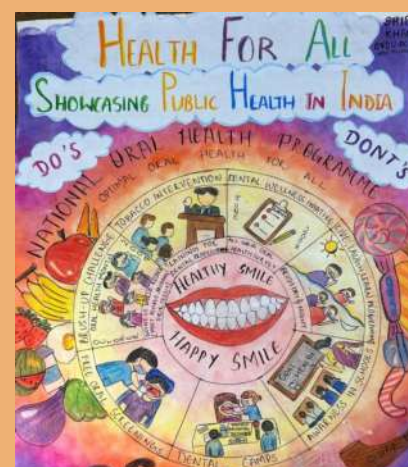
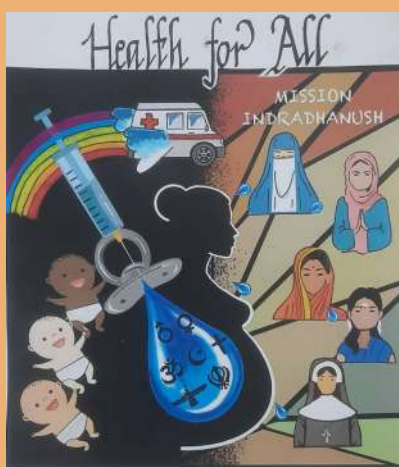
