I am happy to present the report of IIHMR University, Jaipur, for the month of February 2023.

During the month, the university made significant strides in its mission to enhance human resource capacity in the healthcare sector through various management development programs. One such initiative was the organization of a workshop on Biomedical Waste Management Rules, 2016, in collaboration with the Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board. The workshop was designed for doctors and staff of SMS Medical College Attached Hospitals. Additionally, the MANSI project, implemented by Tata Steel Foundation, received training on project management and documentation skills through a Management Development Program (MDP) for working professionals.

IIHMR University also conducted capacity-building programs for the link workers scheme and targeted intervention (TI) project functionaries in Rajasthan. In collaboration with WISH Foundation and Medical and Health Department, Govt of Rajasthan, the university organized a training program on Health System Resilience for over 700 staff working at Urban Primary Health Care Centres of Jaipur.

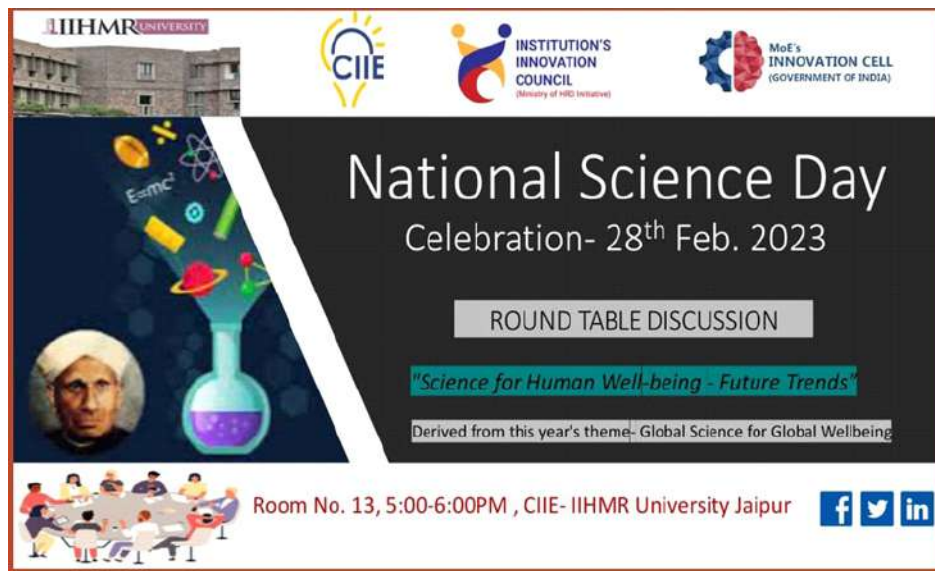


National Science Day
