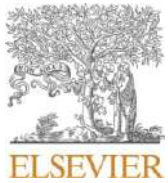

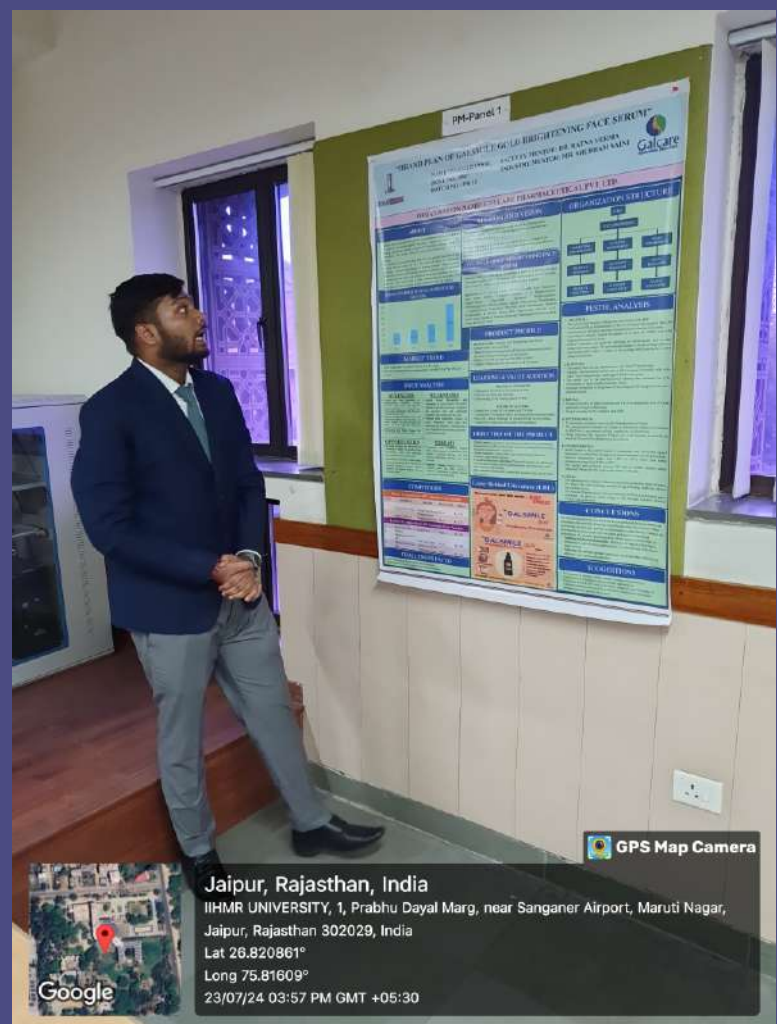
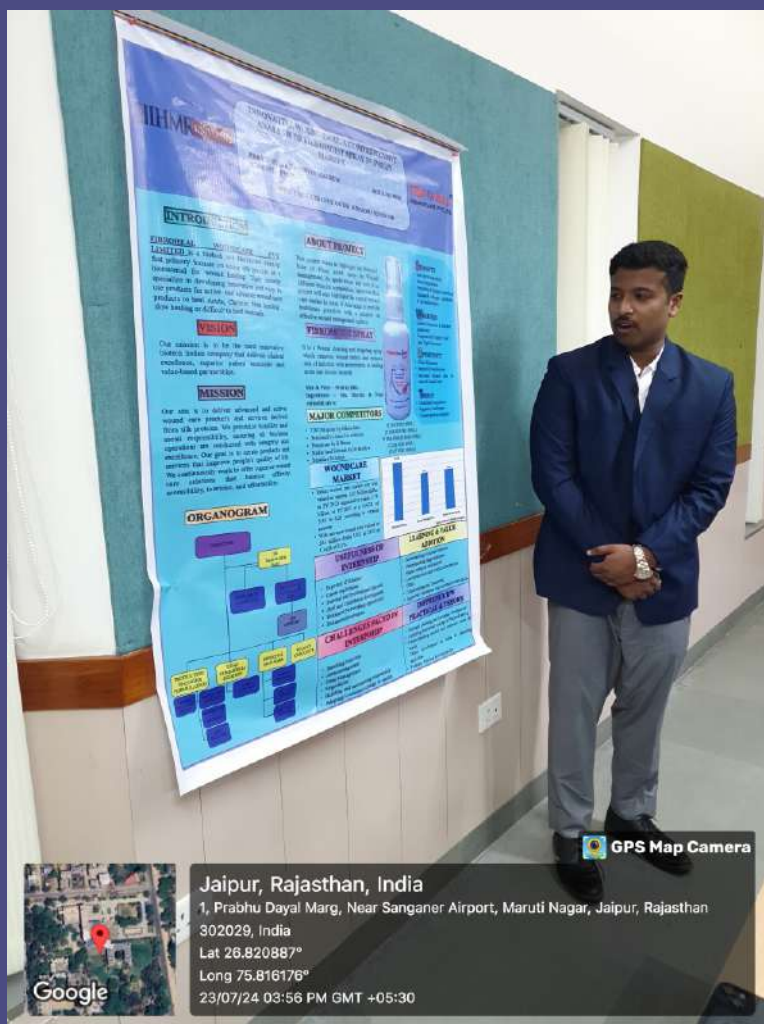


Summer Internship Presentation
