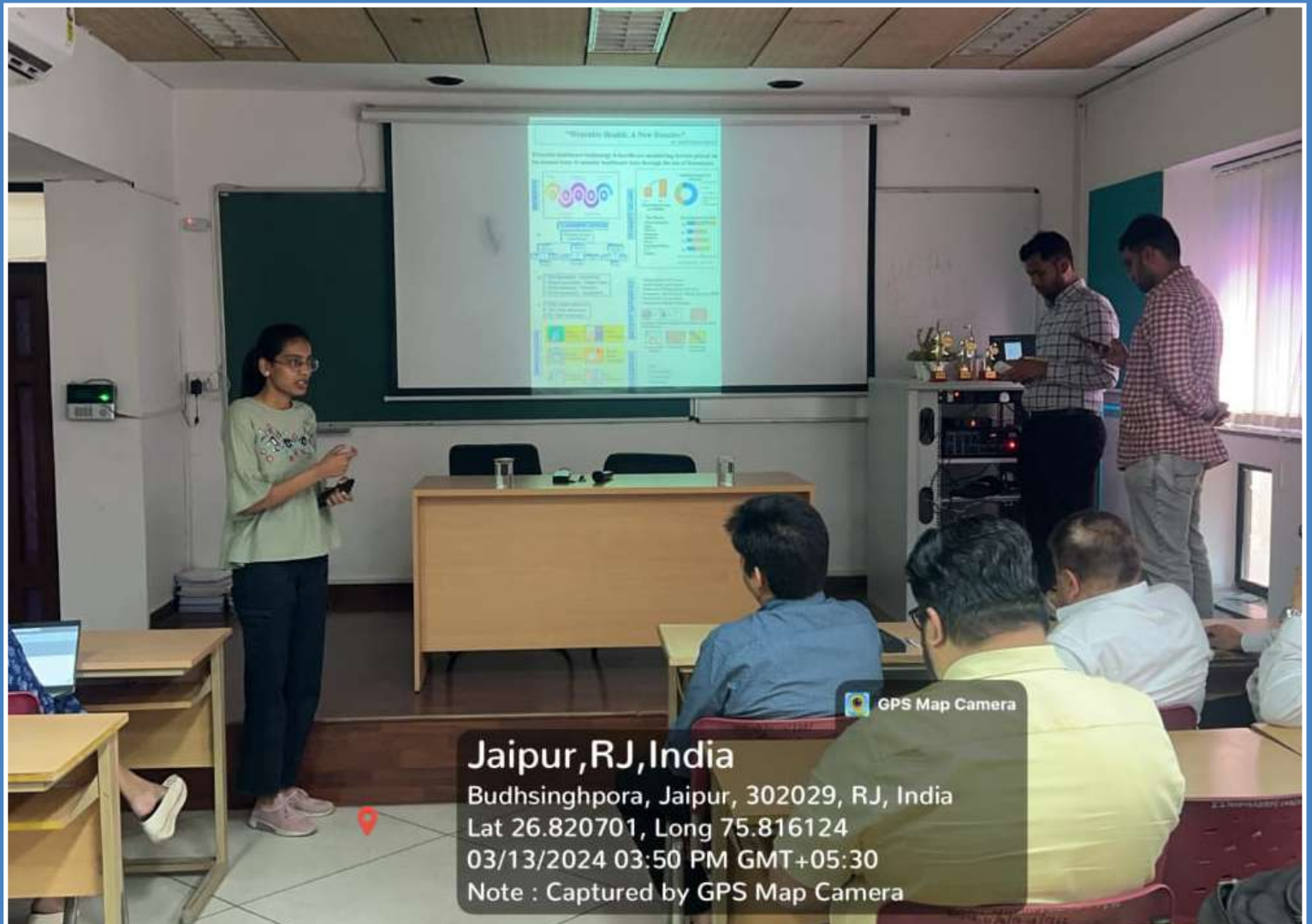




## E-Poster Competition

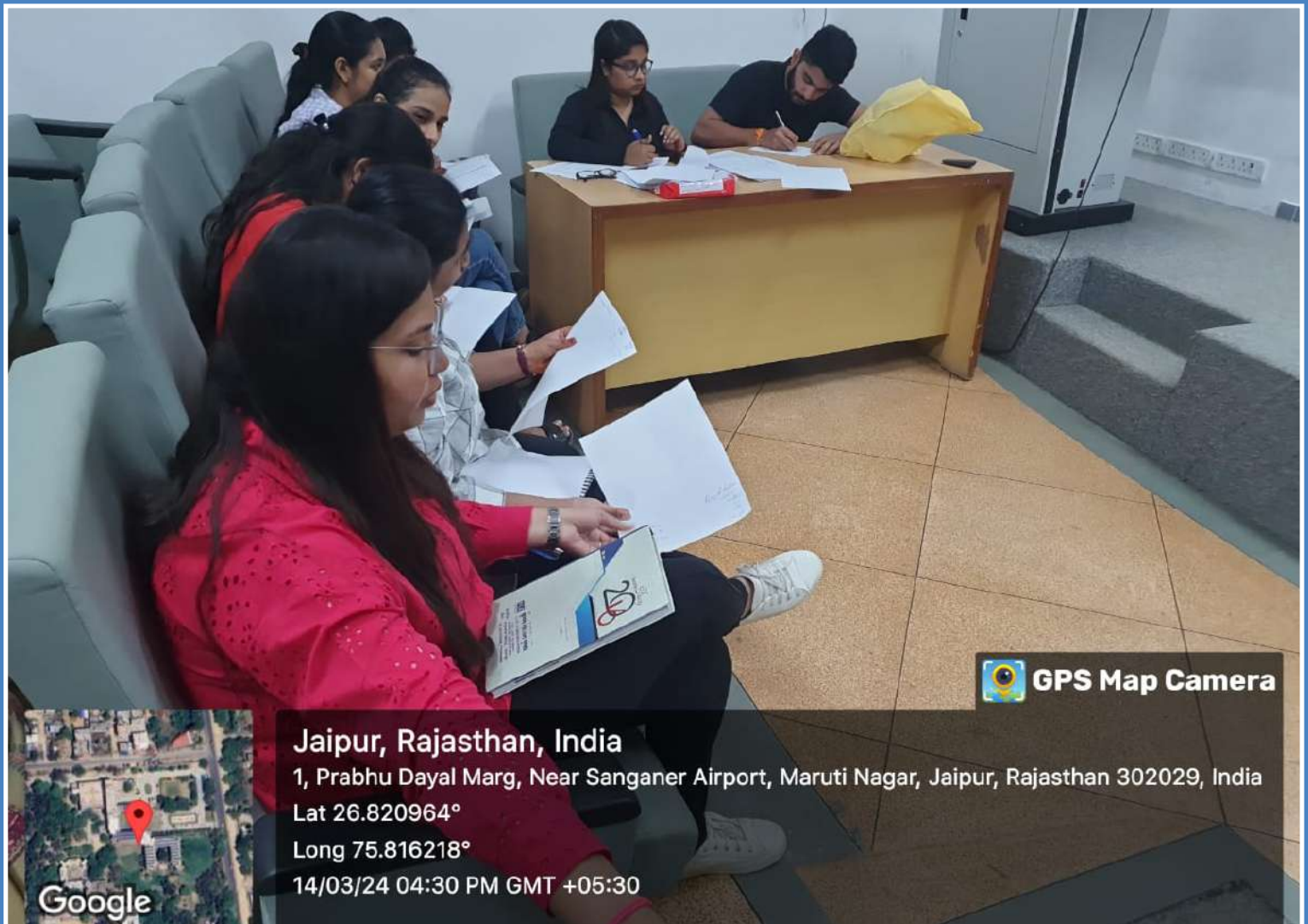






# Enhancing Executive Presence for Placements Sessions under Language and Communication March 14, 2024

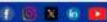
