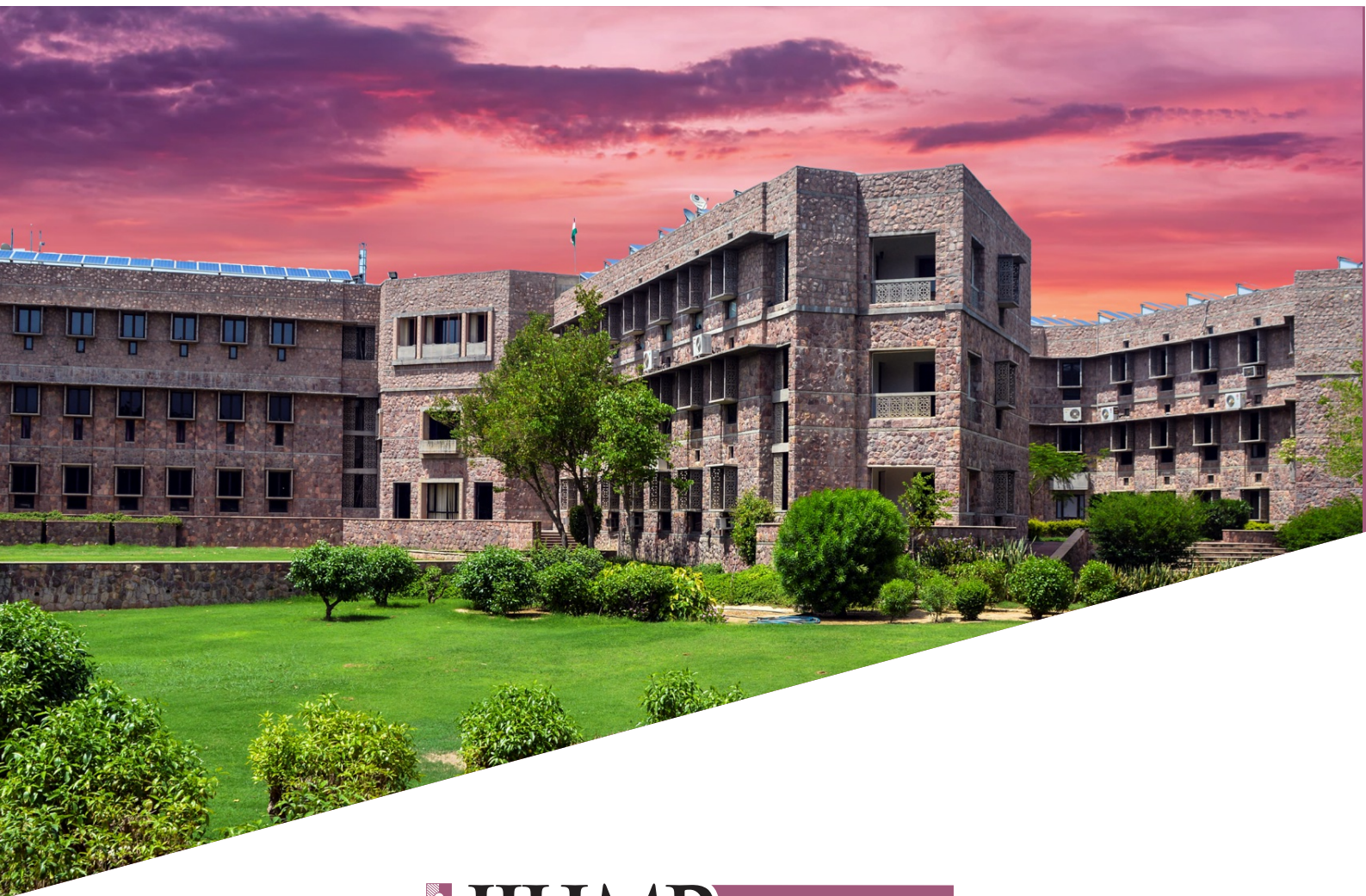

आयुष्मान डिजिटल मिशन, चुनौतियां भी कम नहीं

के चौड़ा होने की आशंका को खत्म करने के लिए निरंतर और विशेष प्रयास करने होंगे। सेवाओं तक पहुंच, प्रभावकारिता, दक्षता और प्रभावशीलता में आसानी का लाभ सभी तक पहुंचना चाहिए। डिजिटल स्वास्थ्य मिशन में यही वादा किया गया है। डिजिटल खाई को पाटने के लिए सरकार को समर्पित वित्तीय संसाधन आवंटित करने होंगे। राजनीतिक संस्थाओं में मजबूत इच्छाशक्ति की आवश्यकता होगी।

गोपनीयता, सुरक्षा और स्वास्थ्य डेटा के दुरुपयोग के बारे में भी विशेषज्ञ चिंता जताते रहे हैं। प्रत्येक व्यक्ति को अपने डेटा की गोपनीयता का स्वाभाविक अधिकार है।

कार्ड पर संग्रहीत स्वास्थ्य डेटा डॉक्टर, फार्मासिस्ट, डायग्नोस्टिक लैब और अस्पताल के पास जाएगा। रोगी के रेकॉर्ड की गोपनीयता और कई चैनलों के बीच प्रवाहित होने वाले डेटा की सुरक्षा सुनिश्चित की जानी चाहिए। मजबूत फायरवॉल और डेटा सुरक्षा प्रोटोकॉल विकसित करने होंगे। देश में बैंकिंग सेक्टर में साइबर क्राइम बढ़ रहे हैं। हैकर्स स्वास्थ्य डेटा तक पहुंच बनाने, इसे चुराने और ऐसे के लिए इसे व्यावसायिक रूप से बेचने की कोशिश करेंगे। बड़े पैमाने पर स्वास्थ्य डेटा तक आसान पहुंच से कई अनैतिक कृत्य हो सकते हैं। सख्त साइबर कानून लागू करने होंगे। अनुसंधान या व्यापार में डेटा के दुरुपयोग की संभावना भी रहेगी। सख्त मानदंड और प्रोटोकॉल विकसित करने होंगे।

एक अन्य समस्या डेटा की गलत रेकॉर्डिंग या भंडारण की है। यदि रेकॉर्डिंग त्रुटियां या डेटाबेस त्रुटियां हैं, तो यह सिस्टम बाधाओं या स्वास्थ्य खतरों को जन्म देगा। विभिन्न स्तरों पर स्वास्थ्य अभिलेखों का प्रमाणीकरण, क्रॉसचेकिंग और डेटा का प्रमाणीकरण करना होगा। एक छोटी सी चूक से पूरा सिस्टम चरमरा सकता है।
