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Executive Summary

I am pleased to share the November 2024 activity report for IIHMR University, showcasing a month filled with impactful collaborations, academic advancements, and community-focused initiatives.

This month, the University strengthened its network with key Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) signed with the Maternity Foundation and Ibtada Foundation, aimed at fostering joint initiatives such as webinars, seminars, and conferences to disseminate scientific knowledge. A landmark MoU was also signed with the Rajasthan State AIDS Control Society (RSACS) to build capacity under the “Link Workers Scheme” and Targeted Intervention Projects in Rajasthan.

On the academic and research front, IIHMR hosted two insightful workshops under the ongoing WHO-supported project “Empowering Adolescents to Lead Change Using Health Data.” The first, on November 14, focused on mental health and resilience, while the second, on November 16, emphasized promoting healthy lifestyles through physical activity. Additionally, the University partnered with Water.org for a WASH impact assessment and hosted a Training of Trainers (ToT) session on November 25.

The University also prioritized professional development, conducting a three-day MDP on Analytics & Decision Support in Healthcare Operations Management (Nov 18-20) and an engaging session on Workplace Ethics (Nov 29-30) under its Staff Development Program. Other highlights included a professional etiquette session (Nov 19) for MBA students and a visit from M.Sc. (Nursing) students from Rajkiya College of Nursing (Nov 8), showcasing IIHMR’s vibrant learning environment.

These milestones reflect IIHMR University’s continued dedication to fostering innovation, strengthening partnerships, and driving impactful education and research initiatives in public health and management.

Training of Trainers



Water.org collaborated with the Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD) to highlight the role of SHGs and NRLMs in supporting the Swachh Bharat Mission, proposing the inclusion of "toilet construction" as a loan category under SRLMs.

It also commissioned IIHMR University to assess the impact of WASH facilities on communities, focusing on loan utilization, borrower experiences, and the influence of water and sanitation assets on behavior and health. To support this study, a Training of Trainers (ToT) session was held for the IIHMR team of 6 participants on November 25, 2024.



Workshop on Enhancing Capacity of School Teachers for Mental Well-being of Students
