Two Parallel Roads Impacting the Functional Preparedness of Accredited Hospitals: The Indian Healthcare Quality Standards and Disaster Management Act 2005

Abstract

Background: Quality management of healthcare service providers and disaster preparedness are two important aspects that affect patient safety and the overall outcome of care delivery. Accreditation standards and legal framework for disaster management are intertwined and pave the way for achieving the optimum level of safety in healthcare system. **Aims:** The aim of the study is to evaluate the functional preparedness of hospital staff for managing disaster situations. **Materials and Methods:** It was a quantitative, cross-sectional, ex-post-facto study to understand the functional elements by deeply studying the Knowledge, Attitude and Practice (KAP) scores of various level hospital staff. **Results:** Knowledge scores of the participants showed positive correlation with attitude scores ($r = 0.424$, $P < 0.001$) and practice scores ($r = 0.446$, $P < 0.001$). The study showed a significant difference between mean KAP score of males (14.96 ± 3.5) and female (16.38 ± 2.6). Similarly, the staff who obtained excellent scores in the KAP study belonged to a higher age group while those who obtained poor were in the lowest age group ($F(2, 715) = 10.739$; $P < 0.001$). The performance of staff significantly increased ($P < 0.01$) with increase in age as number of years of experience and on-the-job training enriched their understanding. In spite, of the same level of inputs in terms of training and sensitization inputs, the staff of Administration departments showed higher knowledge than other staff ($\chi^2 = 97.37$, $P < 0.001$). Analysis of educational qualification of participants elicits that it has a statistically significant effect on their performance in KAP study ($F(5, 709) = 12.82$; $P < 0.001$). **Conclusion:** The KAP scores are direct indicator of effectiveness of quality standards in preparing the hospital for disaster management. The study shows that variables like age, gender, department, educational qualification are correlated with performance and affect the attitude and practice during a disaster event.

INTRODUCTION

A hospital can be considered as “Safe hospitals”^[1] if it is not restricted to the physical and functional integrity of the particular health facilities however but it extends beyond to function at full capacity and cater to the needs of affected community as early as possible in the eventuality of disaster situation. The quality processes implemented by hospitals to improve preparedness toward disasters have been referred to as facility management and safety as per the NABH standards.^[2] A considerable amount of research studies are available to understand the effect of disaster and the various factors related to its management by the healthcare staff. However, there are no studies that evidence the effect of accreditation on disaster management. Therefore, it is the right time to assess the level of

preparation in the accredited hospitals in the country to manage disasters. Moreover, there are no moral or legal obligations stated by the Disaster management act^[3] or the accreditation standards which are tied together or compel the hospitals to look into both the issues simultaneously. There is also dearth of evidence in support of implementation of the hospital-related clause mentioned in disaster management act. Second, the

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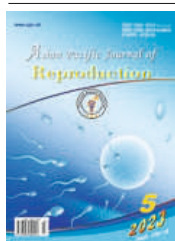

IIHMR University organised International Training Program on Family Planning and Reproductive Health Commodity Security

October 03, 2023: The IIHMR University, in collaboration with the UNFPA Asia Pacific Regional Office, held a two-week International Training Program on Family Planning and Reproductive Health Commodity Security on the university campus from September 18 to 29, 2023. This is the sixth program in a long line of successful programs aimed at increasing capacity in the critical fields of RHCS and Family Planning. This year's program included 33 participants from 11 countries: Bangladesh, Bhutan, Fiji, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, Nepal, Papua New Guinea, Samoa, Sri Lanka, and Timor-Leste. The primary objective of the training is to enhance participants' comprehension of RHCS and SPARHCS while equipping them with improved leadership and managerial skills, ultimately contributing to the advancement of FP and RHCS areas. The opening ceremony began with the symbolic lighting of the lamp and an invocation to the goddess Saraswati, followed by a warm welcome by Dr. P.R. Sodani, President of IIHMR University, Jaipur. Dr. Sodani briefed the audience on the accomplishments of five programs that were conducted annually in 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, and 2022, and citing those 129 participants from 19 different nations had benefited overall from this program. He also discussed the pedagogy of the programme which includes diverse range of instructional methods, that involves lectures, discussions, case analyses, group work, assignments, field visits, and hands-on experiential learning. In continuation, Dr. Vinit Sharma, Regional Adviser for Reproductive Health and Reproductive Health Commodity Security (RH & RHCS) at UNFPA's Asia Pacific Regional Office in Bangkok, Thailand, highlighted the history of collaboration between UNFPA and IIHMR University. In 2014, UNFPA began identifying institutions in the region for capacity building in RHCS and FP. IIHMR University, Jaipur, emerged as a promising institution for delivering comprehensive courses in these areas. Furthermore, Dr. S.D. Gupta, Trustee Secretary of IIHMR, delivered the inaugural address, emphasizing

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This is the sixth program in a series of successful initiatives that have been instrumental in building capacity in the vital field of RHCS and Family Planning. This year's program hosts 33 participants representing eleven countries, including Bangladesh, Bhutan, Fiji, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, Nepal, Papua New Guinea, Samoa, Sri Lanka, and Timor-Leste. The primary objective of the training is to enhance participants' comprehension of RHCS and SPARHCS while equipping them with improved leadership and managerial skills, ultimately contributing to the advancement of FP and RHCS areas. The opening ceremony began with the symbolic lighting of the lamp and an invocation to the goddess Saraswati, followed by a warm welcome by Dr. P.R. Sodani, President of IIHMR University, Jaipur. Dr. Sodani briefed the audience on the accomplishments of five programs that were conducted annually in 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, and 2022, and citing those 129 participants from 19 different nations had benefited overall from this program. He also discussed the pedagogy of the programme which includes diverse range of instructional methods, that involves lectures, discussions, case analyses, group work, assignments, field visits, and hands-on experiential learning. In continuation, Dr. Vinit Sharma, Regional Adviser for Reproductive Health and Reproductive Health Commodity Security (RH & RHCS) at UNFPA's Asia Pacific Regional Office in Bangkok, Thailand, highlighted the history of collaboration between UNFPA and IIHMR University. In 2014, UNFPA began identifying institutions in the region for capacity building in RHCS and FP. IIHMR University, Jaipur, emerged as a promising institution for delivering comprehensive courses in these areas. Furthermore, Dr. S.D. Gupta, Trustee Secretary of IIHMR, delivered the inaugural address, emphasizing
