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Executive Summary

I am happy to share the Monthly Report for September 2025, showcasing IIHMR University's commitment to academic excellence, research, and community engagement. The month featured impactful academic initiatives, field visits, and collaborative programs that enriched experiential learning and leadership development.

A major highlight was the Hospital Management Training Program for Senior Medical Officers from Punjab, addressed virtually by Dr. Balbir Singh, Hon'ble Health Minister of Punjab, who commended IIHMR University for strengthening hospital efficiency and professional capacity. He also emphasized the importance of continued collaboration with IIHMR University for future training and development programs.

IIMH University Places Public Health Education on National Agenda; Experts Call for Region-Specific Solutions

Mumbai: Taking forward the vision of placing research health systems, IIMH University, a collaboration with the Indian Council for Public Health Education (ICPHE), organized the first session of the National Alliance for Strengthening of Public Health Education Program in the north-west India Region (NAIPHE).

The key is centered on providing education that will ensure public health education throughout their life span."

Dr. D.D. Gupta, President of IIMH and President of IAPHEM, shared his personal experience and underscored the importance of capacity building, leadership development, and fostering performance, giving public health professionals to promote innovation and progress-based learning across the nation.

The closing remarks were by Prof. A. Anand Kumar, Chairman, IIMH, Vice-Chancellor, IIT Bombay, and President, IAPHEM.
