



Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU") is made on **August 29, 2022**, between **IIHMR University**, having its registered office at T, Prabhu Dayal Marg, Sanganer Airport, Jaipur-302029, Rajasthan, represented by Dr. P. R. Sodani, President hereinafter referred to as the "**First Party**", which term unless repugnant to the context thereof shall mean and include its legal heirs, successors, nominees and permitted assigns, etc.).

AND

Rajasthan University of Health Sciences (RUHS) located at Sector-18, Kumbha Marg, Pratap Nagar, Jaipur-302033, Rajasthan, India, represented by Dr. Sudhir Bhandari, Vice Chancellor, Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur, Jaipur (hereinafter referred to as the "**Second Party**", which term unless repugnant to the context thereof shall mean and include its successors and permitted assigns).

1. Partner Background

The genesis of the **IIHMR University, Jaipur** (First Party) dates to October 5, 1984, when the Indian Institute of Health Management Research (IIHMR) was established. The IIHMR University has been established and incorporated as a postgraduate research University by the Government of Rajasthan vide the IIHMR University, Jaipur Act, 2014 (Act No. 3, of 2014). IIHMR University is UGC recognized, NAAC accredited, and ranked 73rd NIRF 2021 (Management). IIHMR University is dedicated to the improvement in standards of health through better management of health care and related programmes. It seeks to accomplish this through management research, education, training, consultation, and networking in a national and global perspective.

IIHMR University offers MBA (Hospital and Health Management), MBA (Pharmaceutical Management), MBA (Development Management), Master of Public Health (in collaboration with Johns Hopkins University, USA), Master of public Health (Implementation Science), Executive Education, and PhD programmes. We have collaborations with international and prestigious universities including Johns Hopkins university, USA, Manchester University, UK, Curtin University, Australia for student exchange, faculty exchange, joint research and capacity building programmes.

The University aims to disseminate and advance knowledge in medical and health sciences. The University provides academic and research facilities in various streams to the students studying in various Government Colleges (Medical, Dental, Nursing, Pharmacy & Paramedical) and private colleges/institutions affiliated to this University. The University endeavors the process of making itself a leader in world class medical education by focusing on the systemic instructions, teaching, training, and research activities.

2. Scope of MoU

The MoU outlines the broad framework of understanding between IIHMR University, Jaipur and Rajasthan University of Health Sciences (RUHS) to formally establish continuing collaboration by identifying and developing areas of cooperation.

3. General Purpose

- 3.1** Under this MoU, the IIHMR University, Jaipur would be the "Mentoring Institute" for Institute of Public Health (Constituent Institution of Rajasthan University of Health Sciences) in execution of the Master of Public Health (MPH).
- 3.2** IIHMR University, Jaipur will mentor Institute of Public Health in academic planning, identifying faculty for teaching various subjects under MPH program, providing faculty support for teaching various subjects under MPH program as desired by RUHS time to time.

4. Confidentiality

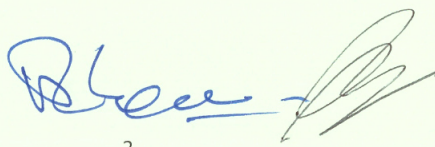
- 4.1** Each Party shall undertake to observe confidentiality and secrecy of documents and information received from the other Party during the term of the MoU or any other agreements executed pursuant to this MoU. This obligation shall survive even after the termination of the agreement.
- 4.2** This is exclusive of those cases in which disclosure of such confidential documents or information is mandatory under prevailing laws.

5 Force Majeure

Both parties shall not be responsible for any failure to perform to unforeseen circumstances or to causes beyond their reasonable control, including but not limited to act of nature, war, riot, embargoes, acts of civil or military authorities, fire, floods, accidents, terrorist activities, strikes or shortages of transportation, facilities, fuel, energy, labor or materials. In the event of any such aspect being beyond the control of participating agencies, appropriate strategies would be worked out to compensate the activities/ schedules accordingly.

6 Duration

The MoU would be effective for a period of two years, from the date of its execution (i.e., signing by both parties). It may be extended after expiry of two years and on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon. This Agreement will remain valid and in force until the date that is two years after the date of execution, unless either party provide the other with written notice of nonrenewal at least thirty (30) days prior to the completion of validity of MoU.



7 Termination

Either party may terminate this MoU, without prejudice to any other remedy for any breach of MoU, by written notice for a period of 30 days.

8 Amendments

8.1 Either Party may request in writing for a revision, amendment or modification of all or any part of this MoU.

8.2 Any revision, amendment or modification agreed to between the Parties shall be in writing and shall come into force on such date as determined by the Parties and shall form part of this MoU.

9 Conflict of Interest

Both Parties warrant that this MoU is not likely to have any conflict of interest with any of their organizational, financial, contractual, or other interests relating to the activities under this MoU. Both parties also agree that this MoU will not be treated as a deterrent to allow similar activities or collaboration with other organizations.

10 Resolution of Disputes

10.1 Any dispute arising between parties to this MoU will be put forward before an Arbitrator who will be appointed after consulting both parties.

10.2 The Arbitrator is to be located in Jaipur. Adjudication if any, and unavoidable will be of courts in Jaipur.

In witness thereof, the duly authorized representatives of the collaborating parties sign this Memorandum of Understanding.

The Parties herein have entered and executed this MoU on the date mentioned above.
