Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU") is made on **August 30, 2022**, between **IIHMR University**, having its registered office at 1, Prabhu Dayal Marg, Sanganer Airport, Jaipur-302029, Rajasthan, represented by Dr. P. R. Sodani, President hereinafter referred to as the "**First Party**", which term unless repugnant to the context there of shall mean and include its legal heirs, successors, nominees and permitted assigns, etc.).

AND

Apex Hospitals located at SP-6, Malviya Industrial Area, Jaipur represented by Dr. Sheenu Jhawar, Director, Apex Hospitals, Jaipur (hereinafter referred to as the "**Second Party**", which term unless repugnant to the context thereof shall mean and include its successors and permitted assigns).

1. Partner Background

The genesis of the **IIHMR University, Jaipur** (First Party) dates to October 5, 1984, when the Indian Institute of Health Management Research (IIHMR) was established. The IIHMR University has been established and incorporated as a postgraduate research University by the Government of Rajasthan vide the IIHMR University, Jaipur Act, 2014 (Act No. 3, of 2014). IIHMR University is UGC recognized, NAAC accredited, and ranked 73rd NIRF 2021 (Management). IIHMR University is dedicated to the improvement in standards of health through better management of health care and related programmes. It seeks to accomplish this through management research, education, training, consultation, and networking in a national and global perspective. IIHMR University offers MBA (Hospital and Health Management), MBA (Pharmaceutical Management), MBA (Development Management), Master of Public Health (in collaboration with Johns Hopkins University, USA), Master of public Health (Implementation Science), Executive Education, and PhD programmes. We have collaborations with international and prestigious universities including Johns Hopkins university, USA, Manchester University, UK, Curtin University, Australia for student exchange, faculty exchange, joint research and capacity building programmes.

Apex Hospitals is a chain of 5 multi-specialty hospitals in Rajasthan with two facilities in Jaipur, Bikaner, Sawai Madhopur and Jhunjhunu at present. NABH and NABL accredited Apex Hospitals is one of the fastest growing hospitals in Rajasthan. It has experienced team of doctors, state-of-the-art infrastructure, and best of advanced medical technology and unwavering compassion that has made Apex Hospital provide top-quality and patient-focused healthcare services since 1994.

2. Scope of MoU

The MoU outlines the broad framework of understanding between IIHMR University, Jaipur and Apex Hospitals, Jaipur to formally establish continuing collaboration by identifying and developing areas of cooperation.

3. Purpose

- 3.1 Under this MoU, the IIHMR University would like to send post graduate students/ research scholars for their internship/dissertation/practicum to Apex Hospitals. The dissertations/internship undertaken by IIHMR University post graduate student will help Apex Hospitals for improving hospital efficiency and functions.
- 3.2 IIHMR University would like to explore opportunities for research scholars for pursuing their doctoral degree work with hospital-based data at Apex Hospitals. The research undertaken by IIHMR University doctoral student will help Apex Hospital for improving hospital efficiency and functions.
- 3.3 IIHMR University desires to send the post graduate students/training participants for exposure visits to Apex Hospitals for better understanding of hospital functions.
- 3.4 IIHMR University would like to engage with Apex Hospitals in writing joint research proposals/ papers and organizing workshops/ conferences/ seminars/training programmes.
- 3.5 It is further clarified that the internship/dissertation/practicum shall be implemented/ undertaken by the student in accordance with Apex Hospitals standard operating procedures.
- 3.6 Any data/ report relating to the internship/dissertation/practicum shall be submitted to Apex Hospitals for review and comments prior to submission to IIHMR University by the student.
- 3.7 IIHMR University student may explore placement opportunities at Apex Hospitals.
- 3.8 The First Party shall endeavor and insist on its student, at all times during the Term of this MoU and while on the premises of Apex Hospitals, to comply with the rules and regulations prescribed by Apex Hospitals. Student/Researcher scholar must maintain harmonious relations with the patients, their attendants/ visitors, employees and staff of Apex hospitals. It is hereby clarified that Apex hospitals reserves the right to forthwith terminate the MoU and/ or enrolment of the Student/Researcher/ scholar, in the event of any misconduct/ illegal act of the Researcher/ any scholar during the Term of this MoU.

4. Confidentiality

Each of the Parties shall maintain the utmost confidentiality, regarding the contents of this MoU at all times, and no Party shall use or disclose any confidential information of the other Party for any other purpose. The First Party shall endeavor and insist on its student/ Researcher/ scholar to maintain strict confidentiality of any and all information gathered by them or comes to their knowledge while at the premises of Apex hospitals during the duration of this MoU.

5. Force Majeure

Both parties shall not be responsible for any failure to perform to unforeseen circumstances or to causes beyond their reasonable control, including but not limited to act of nature, war, riot, embargoes, acts of civil or military authorities, fire, floods, accidents, terrorist activates, strikes or shortages of transportation, facilities, fuel, energy, labor or materials. In the event of any such aspect being beyond the control of participating agencies, appropriate strategies would be worked out to compensate the activities/ schedules accordingly.

6. Liability

Both IIHMR University, Jaipur and Apex Hospitals, Jaipur shall be solely liable for any damages/claims against it in connection with the exercise of the objectives of this MoU hereunder, unless agreed upon otherwise by both the parties. Liability for specific activities jointly undertaken by parties shall be referred to in the specific agreements executed.

7. Duration

The MoU would be effective for a period of three years, from the date of its execution (i.e., signing by both parties). It may be extended after expiry of three years and on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon. This Agreement will remain valid and in force until the date that is five years after the date of execution, unless either party provide the other with written notice of nonrenewal at least thirty (30) days prior to the completion of validity of MoU.

8. Termination

Either party may terminate this MoU, without prejudice to any other remedy for any breach of MoU, by written notice for a period of 30 days.

9. Amendments

- 9.1 Either Party may request in writing for a revision, amendment or modification of all or any part of this MoU.
- 9.2 Any revision, amendment or modification agreed to between the Parties shall be in writing and shall come into force on such date as determined by the Parties and shall form part of this MoU.

10. Conflict of Interest

Both Parties warrant that this MoU is not likely to have any conflict of interest with any of their organizational, financial, contractual, or other interests relating to the activities under this MoU. Both parties also agree that this MoU will not be treated as a deterrent to allow similar activities or collaboration with other organizations.

11. Resolution of Disputes

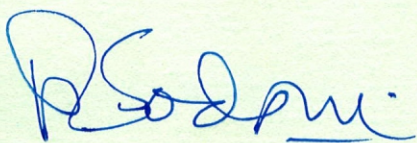
- 11.1 Any dispute arising between parties to this MoU will be put forward before an Arbitrator who will be appointed after consulting both parties.
- 11.2 The Arbitrator is to be located in NCT Delhi. Adjudication if any, and unavoidable will be of courts in NCT Delhi.
