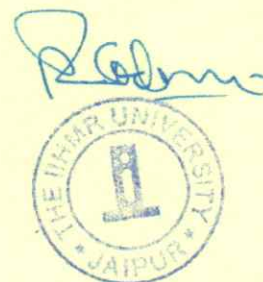

Memorandum of Understanding

Between:

Universitas Islam Bandung is a private higher education established under the Notaries Deed No. 42 Lie Kwee Nio on 15 November 1958 for the purposes of managing the Islamic College, having its address at Jalan Tamansari No. 20 Bandung 40116, West Java, Indonesia (hereinafter referred to as "UNISBA")

and

IIHMR University, Jaipur, India : The genesis of the IIHMR University, Jaipur dates to October 5, 1984, when the Indian Institute of Health Management Research (IIHMR) was established. The IIHMR University has been established and incorporated as a postgraduate research University by the Government of Rajasthan vide the IIHMR University, Jaipur Act, 2014 (Act No. 3, of 2014). IIHMR University is UGC recognized, NAAC accredited. IIHMR University is dedicated to the improvement in standards of health through better management of health care and related programmes. It seeks to accomplish this through management research, education, training, consultation, and networking in a national and global perspective. IIHMR University offers MBA (Hospital and Health Management), MBA (Pharmaceutical Management), MBA (Development Management), MBA (Healthcare Analytics) Master of Public Health (Offered by Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health, Baltimore, MD, USA in cooperation with IIHMR University, Jaipur, India), Master of public Health (Implementation Science) program under the WHO-TDR postgraduate training scheme., Executive Education Programs, Online Certificate Courses and PhD programmes.

UNISBA and UBD shall be collectively referred to as "the Parties" and individually as "the Party". This Memorandum of Understanding (hereafter MoU) constitutes a framework for cooperation between the two parties in various fields and agrees to the following:

Article 1

Scope of Cooperation

Each institution will make an effort to promote and develop cooperation in the following activities based upon the principles of equality and reciprocity. However, lists of activities are not exhaustive and may be added from time to time with the mutual agreement of the Parties:

1. Facilitating educational, research, and community service initiatives;
2. Enhancing the competencies of human resources;
3. Facilitating student internship programs;
4. Provision of Expert Assistance;
5. Facilitating the organization of training sessions and certification programs;
6. Organizing public lectures, conferences, seminars, symposia, workshops, short courses, and various scholarly activities;
7. Collaborating on institutional initiatives;
8. Student and faculty exchange
9. Other activities agreed upon by all parties.

Article 2

Duration and Termination



1. This Memorandum of Understanding shall come into force on the date of signing and shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years from the date of this Memorandum of Understanding subject. However, to annual review and modification, as mutually agreed upon.
2. Thereafter, if the Parties hereto wish to extend the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding, they shall do so by an express covenant in writing upon terms and conditions to be mutually agreed upon.
3. Notwithstanding anything in this Article, either Party may terminate this Memorandum of Understanding by notifying the other Party of its intention to terminate this Memorandum of Understanding by notice in writing, at least three (3) months before its termination date. Termination shall be without penalty.
4. Such notice of termination does not affect any prior obligation, project program, or activity already in progress.

Article 3

General Provisions

1. The Parties, subject to the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding and the laws, rules, and regulations from time to time in force in each Party's country, will endeavor to strengthen, promote and develop academic, research, institutional development, and capacity building skills between the Parties on a non-exclusive basis, and based on equality and mutual benefit.
2. Each Party will endeavor to take necessary steps to encourage and develop academic exchange in education and research and as agreed upon in the list of activities as set out in Article 1 of this Memorandum of Understanding based on principles of equality and reciprocity of mutual benefits.
3. The development and implementation of specific activities based on this Memorandum of Understanding will be separately negotiated and agreed upon between the faculties or institutes which carry out the specific projects in the Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) and/or Implementation of Arrangement (IA).
4. Both parties agree to follow all the provisions contained in the MoU, MoA, and IA, which have been adapted to the regulations and laws of the countries of both parties.
5. Each of the Parties hereto confirms its intention to promote the Parties hereto's best interests and consult fully on all matters materially affecting the areas of cooperation. Each of the Parties hereto shall act in good faith towards the other Party to promote the success of the contemplated cooperation.

Article 4

Financial Arrangement

1. This Memorandum of Understanding will not give rise to any financial obligation by one Party to the other. Each Party will bear its own cost and expenses to the activities under this Memorandum of Understanding.
2. The Parties agree to discuss and further negotiate before implementing any specific academic program(s) and/or research project(s) on a specific budget.
3. Any intellectual property derived under collaborative research conducted under this Memorandum of Understanding or any contracts pertaining to the fee for services rendered will be discussed and agreed upon before initiating or commencement of the collaborative research or services rendered and a case-by-case basis under separate agreements.

Article 5

Force Majeure

No Party hereto shall be held responsible or be deemed to be in default or breach of this Memorandum of Understanding for its delay, failure, or inability to meet any of its obligations under this Memorandum



of Understanding (other than any obligation to pay money) caused by or arising from any unavoidable cause or beyond the reasonable control of such party, including war, warlike operations, riot, insurrection, orders of government, strikes, lockouts, public health emergencies, quarantines, disturbances or any act of God or other cause which frustrates the performance of this Memorandum of Understanding.



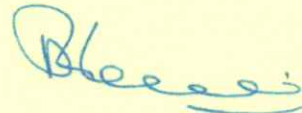
