

**Memorandum of Understanding
between
ASEM Education & Research Hub for Lifelong Learning
and
Stakeholders interested in promoting Lifelong Learning in the South Asia Region**

Background:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into by and between the ASEM Education and Research Hub for Lifelong Learning (hereafter ASEM LLL Hub), represented by Dr Seámus Ó Tuama, Chair of the ASEM LLL Hub and Stakeholders committed to work with Lifelong Learning in South Asia Region, collectively referred to as the "parties", on this day, February 1st, 2024.

Objective:

The parties hereby enter into this MoU to establish a framework for collaboration and partnership in the promotion of lifelong learning research and policy formation. The MOU is aimed at generating mutual benefit for all parties; to help promote the achievement of the ASEM LLL Hub strategic vision as expressed in "A Framework for Lifelong Learning Research in the ASEM Region: 2020-2025"; to facilitate greater visibility and participation by stakeholders interested in promoting Lifelong Learning in the South Asia Region and the activities of the ASEM LLL Hub; to offer the stakeholders interested in promoting Lifelong Learning in the South Asia Region support in framing its own lifelong learning vision.

Terms and Conditions:

1: Scope of Collaboration

The parties agree to collaborate on lifelong learning research and policy formation for mutual benefit and to achieve common objectives.

2: Roles and Responsibilities

Each party shall outline its roles, responsibilities, and contributions to the collaborative efforts. Regular communication and coordination will be maintained to ensure the success of the collaboration.

3: Resource Sharing

The parties may share resources, including but not limited to data, facilities, expertise, and personnel, as deemed necessary for the successful implementation of collaborative projects.

4: Confidentiality

The parties acknowledge the sensitivity of certain information that may be exchanged during the collaboration. Both parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of such information and to use it solely for the purposes outlined in this MoU.

5: Intellectual Property

It is intended that all deliverables of this cooperation shall be open source. However, the parties may develop intellectual property that is not open source, for which the intellectual property rights would accrue to the said parties.

6: Financial Obligations

No party shall incur financial liability arising from this agreement unless mutually agreed.

7: Duration

The agreement will come into effect from the date of most recent signature and is entered into for the duration of Ireland's term as host of the ASEM Lifelong Learning Hub. It may be modified with the consent of the signing parties. Any party may terminate the cooperation on its end provided that notice is given at least 12-weeks in advance.

Any projects, training, or exchanges that may have commenced at any of the signing parties before the date of termination may be completed by special agreement between the signatories.

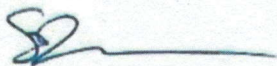
8: Amendments

9. Scope of the Agreement

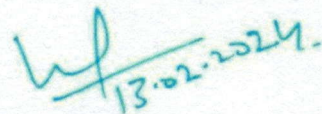
