



Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (“MoU”) is made on **14 February 2025**, between **IIHMR University**, having its registered office at 1, Prabhu Dayal Marg, Sanganer Airport, Jaipur, Rajasthan 302029, represented by Dr. P. R. Sodani, President, hereinafter referred to as the “**First Party**” (which term, unless repugnant to the context thereof, shall mean and include its legal heirs, successors, nominees, permitted assigns, etc.).

AND

Amar Medical & Research Centre by Park Group of Hospitals located at Kiran Path Mansarovar Jaipur 302020, represented by Dr Tej Kumar Sharma, Chief Operating Officer (hereinafter referred to as the “**Second Party**”, which term unless repugnant to the context thereof shall mean and include its successors and permitted assigns).

1. Partner Background

About IIHMR University, Jaipur

The genesis of the **IIHMR University, Jaipur** (First Party) dates to October 5, 1984, when the Indian Institute of Health Management Research (IIHMR) was established. The IIHMR University has been established and incorporated as a postgraduate research University by the Government of Rajasthan vide the IIHMR University, Jaipur Act, 2014 (Act No. 3, of 2014). IIHMR University is UGC recognized, NAAC accredited. IIHMR University is dedicated to the improvement in standards of health through better management of health care and related programs. It seeks to accomplish this through management research, education, training, consultation, and networking in a national and global perspective. IIHMR University offers MBA (Hospital and Health Management), MBA (Pharmaceutical Management), MBA (Development Management), MBA (Healthcare Analytics) Master of Public Health (Offered by Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health, Baltimore, MD, USA in cooperation with IIHMR University, Jaipur, India), Master of public Health (Implementation Science) program under the WHO-TDR postgraduate training scheme., Executive Education Programs, Online Certificate Courses and PhD programs. IIHMR University has strong collaboration with Johns Hopkins University, USA; University of Manchester, UK; University of Montreal, Canada; Management and Science University (MSU) Malaysia, MENDEL University, Brno, Czech; Duquesne University, Pennsylvania, USA; Curtin University Malaysia, Bandung Islamic University, Indonesia and Rajasthan University of Health Sciences for academic advancement, student exchange, faculty exchange, and joint research programs.

2. Scope of the MoU

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) establishes a collaborative framework between IIHMR University, Jaipur, and [Name of Hospital] to foster a mutually beneficial partnership. The MoU aims to identify and develop areas of cooperation that promote academic excellence, research innovation, and professional development while enhancing hospital efficiency and service delivery.

3. Purpose

3.1 Internship, Dissertation, and Practicum

- Under this MoU, IIHMR University will send postgraduate students and research scholars to **AMRC by Park Group of Hospitals** for internships, dissertations, and practicums. These engagements aim to:
- Enhance students' practical knowledge and understanding of hospital operations.
- Contribute to the hospital's efforts to improve its efficiency and functional processes through innovative academic insights.

3.2 Research Collaboration

IIHMR University will explore opportunities for its research scholars to utilize hospital-based data for doctoral research, fostering data-driven insights and evidence-based solutions for healthcare challenges.

3.3 Exposure Visits

The University seeks to organize exposure visits for postgraduate students and training participants at **AMRC by Park Group of Hospitals**. These visits will provide participants with firsthand experience of hospital operations and management practices.

3.4 Joint Research and Academic Initiatives

Both parties will collaborate on:

- Writing and publishing joint research proposals and papers.
- Organizing workshops, conferences, seminars, webinars, and training programs.
- Developing and implementing joint academic and certificate programs to address emerging healthcare trends and challenges.

3.5 Adherence to Standard Operating Procedures

All internship, dissertation, and practicum activities will adhere strictly to the hospital's standard operating procedures (SOPs).

3.6 Data Sharing and Review

Any reports or data generated during internships, dissertations, or practicums will be submitted to [Name of Hospital] for review and feedback before final submission to IIHMR University.

3.7 Placement Opportunities

The MoU will provide opportunities for IIHMR University students to explore potential placements at **AMRC by Park Group of Hospitals** subject to availability and suitability.

3.8 Compliance and Conduct

IIHMR University commits to ensuring that its students and researchers:

- Comply with the rules, regulations, and standards of **AMRC by Park Group of Hospitals**
- Maintain professional and harmonious relationships with patients, attendants, visitors, employees, and staff of the hospital.
- In case of misconduct or illegal activity by any student or researcher, **AMRC by Park Group of Hospitals** and IIHMR University reserve the right to terminate the MoU or the enrolment of the concerned individual.

3.9 Additional Areas of Cooperation

The parties may identify and agree upon additional areas of collaboration that align with their shared goals and objectives as the partnership evolves.

4. Financial Arrangements

This MoU will not give rise to any financial obligation by one Party to the other. Each Party will bear its own costs and expenses in the implementation of this MoU.

5. Confidentiality

Each of the Parties shall maintain the utmost confidentiality, regarding the contents of this MoU always, and no Party shall use or disclose any confidential information of the other Party for any other purpose. The First Party shall endeavor and insist on its student/ Researcher/ scholar to maintain strict confidentiality of all information gathered by them or comes to their knowledge while at the premises of hospital during the duration of this MoU.

6. Force Majeure

Both parties shall not be responsible for any failure to perform to unforeseen circumstances or to causes beyond their reasonable control, including but not limited to act of nature, war, riot, embargoes, acts of civil or military authorities, fire, floods, accidents, terrorist activates, strikes or shortages of transportation, facilities, fuel, energy, labor or materials. In the event of any such aspect being beyond the control of participating agencies, appropriate strategies would be worked out to compensate the activities/ schedules accordingly.

7. Liability

Both IIHMR University, Jaipur and **AMRC by Park Group of Hospitals**, shall be solely liable for any damages/claims against it in connection with the exercise of the objectives of this MoU hereunder, unless agreed upon otherwise by both the parties. Liability for specific activities jointly undertaken by parties shall be referred to in the specific agreements executed.

8. Duration

The MoU would be effective for a period of Five Years, from the date of its execution (i.e., signing by both parties). It may be extended after expiry of three years and on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon. This Agreement will remain valid and in force until the date that is five years after the date of execution, unless either party provide the other with written notice of nonrenewal at least thirty (30) days prior to the completion of validity of MoU.

9. Termination

Either party may terminate this MoU, without prejudice to any other remedy for any breach of MoU, by written notice for a period of 30 days.

10. Amendments

- Either Party may request in writing a revision, amendment or modification of all or any part of this MoU.
- Any revision, amendment or modification agreed to between the Parties shall be in writing and shall come into force on such date as determined by the Parties and shall form part of this MoU.

11. Conflict of Interest

Both Parties warrant that this MoU is not likely to have any conflict of interest with any of their organizational, financial, contractual, or other interests relating to the activities under this MoU. Both parties also agree that this MoU will not be treated as a deterrent to allow similar activities or collaboration with other organizations.

12. Resolution of Disputes

Any dispute arising between parties to this MoU will be put forward before an Arbitrator who will be appointed after consulting both parties.

In witness thereof, the duly authorized representatives of the collaborating parties sign this Memorandum of Understanding.

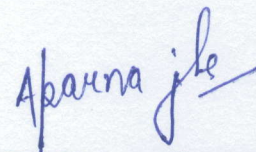

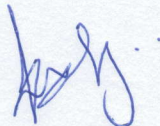

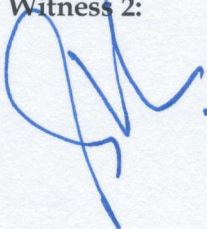
