

Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (“MoU”) is made on 14th day of February, 2025 between **IIHMR University**, having its registered office at 1, Prabhu Dayal Marg, Sanganer Airport, Jaipur, Rajasthan 302029, represented by Dr. P. R. Sodani, President, IIHMR University, Jaipur hereinafter referred to as the “**First Party**”, which term unless repugnant to the context there of shall mean and include its legal heirs, successors, nominees and permitted assigns, etc.).

AND

IIS (Deemed to be University), Jaipur located at Gurukul Marg, SFS, Mansarovar, Jaipur, Rajasthan 302020, represented by Prof. T. N. Mathur, Vice Chancellor, IIS (Deemed to be University), Jaipur (hereinafter referred to as the “**Second Party**”, which term unless repugnant to the context thereof shall mean and include its successors and permitted assigns, etc.).

1. Partner Background

About IIHMR University, Jaipur

The genesis of the **IIHMR University, Jaipur** (First Party) dates to October 5, 1984, when the Indian Institute of Health Management Research (IIHMR) was established. The IIHMR University has been established and incorporated as a postgraduate research University by the Government of Rajasthan vide the IIHMR University, Jaipur Act, 2014 (Act No. 3, of 2014). IIHMR University is UGC recognized, NAAC accredited. IIHMR University is dedicated to the improvement in standards of health through better management of health care and related programmes. It seeks to accomplish this through management research, education, training, consultation, and networking in a national and global perspective. IIHMR University offers MBA (Hospital and Health Management), MBA (Pharmaceutical Management), MBA

(Development Management), MBA (Healthcare Analytics) Master of Public Health (Offered by Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health, Baltimore, MD, USA in cooperation with IIHMR University, Jaipur, India), Master of public Health (Implementation Science) program under the WHO-TDR postgraduate training scheme., Executive Education Programs, Online Certificate Courses and PhD programmes. IIHMR University has strong collaboration with Johns Hopkins University, USA; University of Manchester, UK; University of Montreal, Canada; Management and Science University (MSU) Malaysia, MENDEL University, Brno, Czech; Duquesne University, Pennsylvania, USA; Curtin University Malaysia, Bandung Islamic University, Indonesia and Rajasthan University of Health Sciences for academic advancement, student exchange, faculty exchange, and joint research programs.

About the IIS (Deemed to be University), Jaipur

IIS (deemed to be University), Jaipur established by the notification dated 02.02.2009 issued by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (now Ministry of Education), Govt. of India under section 3 of the UGC Act 1956, is among the pioneers in Rajasthan in imparting quality education to women in different streams. Known for delivering value-based education to students, it encourages them to think innovatively in different walks of life and particularly focuses on preparing students to become world ready citizens. The University is accredited by NAAC-UGC with B++ grade (CGPA= 2.92/4.0) and included in the list of 12 B Institutions by the UGC.

Since inception, Department of Home Science has been a center of excellence for teaching- learning and quality research. The department offers B.Sc. (Honors) Home Science, B.Sc. Pass course with Clinical Dietetics and Food Science and Nutrition as electives at the undergraduate level and M.Sc. in Foods and Nutrition, Human Development and Clothing and Textiles at the

post graduate level as well as Ph.D. in all the three streams. The department also offers Career Oriented and Skill Development courses (COSD/Add on) in Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics (CND), Food Science and Quality Control (FSQ) and Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) at three levels – Certificate, Diploma and Advanced Diploma.

The major thrust areas for research are Public Health Nutrition, Clinical Nutrition, Food Analysis, New Product Development, Behaviour Modification, Children and Women Empowerment, Gerontology, Early Childhood Education and Special Education.

2. Scope of MoU

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between IIHMR University, Jaipur, and IIS (Deemed to be University), Jaipur establishes a comprehensive framework for sustained collaboration in key areas including Research, Training, Academics, and Consultancy.

3. Purpose

3.1. Research and Academic Collaboration

- IIHMR University aims to jointly develop research proposals, co-author research papers, and organize a range of academic events with the partner organization, including trainings, workshops, conferences, seminars, webinars, and joint academic/certificate programs.

3.2 Training Programs

- Develop and deliver customized training modules for relevant stakeholders, addressing emerging trends and challenges in public health.
- Host Joint capacity-building workshops and seminars.

3.3 Student Engagement and Development

- Both the Universities will send postgraduate students and research scholars to the partner organization for internships, dissertations, and practicums, contributing to the improvement of the organization's efficiency and operations.
- Opportunities available for research scholars to utilize project-based data from both the universities for doctoral work will be explored.
- Exposure visits will be organized for postgraduate students and training participants to enhance their understanding of the healthcare environment.
- The expenditure incurred in the research/project work, etc. will be borne by the student/scholar or the institution deputing the student/scholar.

3.4 Adherence to Standards

- All internships, dissertations, and practicums will be conducted in line with the standard operating procedures (SOPs) of respective university where the work is being conducted.
- Any data or reports generated will be reviewed by the respective university where the work has been conducted before submission to the home institution.

3.5 Placement Opportunities

- Students of both the universities may explore potential placement opportunities, if available.

3.6 Additional Areas of Cooperation

- Exchange of students by mutual agreement between both the institute.

- Conducting and participating in webinars/seminars/conferences etc., as a joint collaboration.
- The Parties may identify and engage in further areas of cooperation as mutually agreed upon over time.

4. Financial Arrangements

- This MoU will not give rise to any financial obligation by one Party to the other. Each Party will bear its own cost and expenses in the implementation of this MoU.

5. Confidentiality

Each of the Parties shall maintain the utmost confidentiality, regarding the contents of this MoU at all times, and no Party shall use or disclose any confidential information of the other Party for any other purpose. The First Party shall endeavor and insist on its student/ Researcher/ scholar to maintain strict confidentiality of any and all information gathered by them or comes to their knowledge while at the premises of organization.

6. Force Majeure

Both parties shall not be responsible for any failure to perform to unforeseen circumstances or to causes beyond their reasonable control, including but not limited to act of nature, war, riot, embargoes, acts of civil or military authorities, fire, floods, accidents, terrorist activates, strikes or shortages of transportation, facilities, fuel, energy, labor or materials. In the event of any such aspect being beyond the control of participating agencies, appropriate strategies would be worked out to compensate the activities/ schedules accordingly.

7. Liability

Both, IIHMR University, Jaipur and IIS (Deemed to be University), Jaipur, shall be solely liable for any damages/claims against it in connection with the

exercise of the objectives of this MoU hereunder, unless agreed upon otherwise by both the parties. Liability for specific activities jointly undertaken by parties shall be referred to in the specific agreements executed.

8. Duration

The MoU would be effective for a period of five years, from the date of its execution (i.e., signing by both parties). It may be extended after expiry of five years and on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon. This Agreement will remain valid and in force until the date that is five years after the date of execution, unless either party provide the other with written notice of nonrenewal at least thirty (30) days prior to the completion of validity of MoU.

9. Termination

Either party may terminate this MoU, without prejudice to any other remedy for any breach of MoU, by written notice for a period of 90 days, provided that any ongoing activities shall be completed.

10. Amendments

1. Either Party may request in writing a revision, amendment or modification of all or any part of this MoU.
2. Any revision, amendment or modification agreed to between the Parties shall be in writing and shall come into force on such date as determined by the Parties and shall form part of this MoU.

11. Conflict of Interest

Both Parties warrant that this MoU is not likely to have any conflict of interest with any of their organizational, financial, contractual, or other interests relating to the activities under this MoU. Both parties also agree that this MoU

will not be treated as a deterrent to allow similar activities or collaboration with other organizations.

12. Resolution of Disputes

Any dispute arising between parties to this MoU will be put forward before an Arbitrator who will be appointed after consulting both parties.

In witness thereof, the duly authorized representatives of the collaborating parties sign this Memorandum of Understanding.

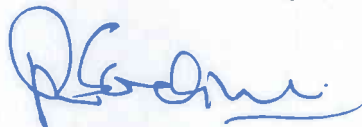
