

Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (“MoU”) is made on **February, 20, 2026** between **IIHMR University**, having its registered office at 1, Prabhu Dayal Marg, Sanganer Airport, Jaipur, Rajasthan 302029, represented by Dr. P. R. Sodani, President, hereinafter referred to as the “First Party” (which term, unless repugnant to the context thereof, shall mean and include its legal heirs, successors, nominees, permitted assigns, etc.).

And

S.N. SUPERSPECIALITY HOSPITAL, SRIGANGANAGAR, having its office at Chak 2-ML, M No 60, Hanumangarh-Suratgarh Bypass, Sri Ganganagar, Rajasthan, 335001, represented by Mr. Ajay Singh Bhati, Head PCS (hereinafter referred to as the “Second Party”, which term, unless repugnant to the context thereof, shall mean and include its successors and permitted assigns).

1. Partner Background

About IIHMR University, Jaipur

The genesis of the **IIHMR University, Jaipur** (First Party) dates to October 5, 1984, when the Indian Institute of Health Management Research (IIHMR) was established. The IIHMR University has been established and incorporated as a postgraduate research University by the Government of Rajasthan vide the IIHMR University, Jaipur Act, 2014 (Act No. 3 of 2014). IIHMR University is UGC-recognised and NAAC-accredited. IIHMR University is dedicated to the improvement in standards of health through better management of health care and related programs. It seeks to accomplish this through management research, education, training, consultation, and networking from a national and global perspective. IIHMR University offers MBA (Hospital and Health Management), MBA (Pharmaceutical Management), MBA (Development Management), MBA (Healthcare Analytics), and Master of Public Health (Offered by Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health, Baltimore, MD, USA in cooperation with IIHMR University, Jaipur, India), Master of Public Health (Implementation Science) program under the WHO-TDR postgraduate training scheme., Executive Education Programs, Online Certificate Courses and PhD programmes. IIHMR University has strong collaboration with Johns Hopkins University, USA; University of Manchester, UK; University of Montreal, Canada, Management and Science University (MSU) Malaysia, MENDEL University, Brno, Czech; Curtin University Malaysia, and Rajasthan University of Health Sciences for academic advancement, student exchange, faculty exchange, and joint research programs.

2. Scope of MoU

The scope of this MoU establishes a comprehensive framework for sustained collaboration in key areas, including Research, Training, Academics, and Consultancy.

3. Purpose

The partnership will focus on the following areas:

- a) **Academic and Professional Engagement:** Jointly develop and organize workshops, conferences, seminars, webinars, and stakeholder consultations to promote knowledge exchange and capacity building.
- b) **Internships and Career Opportunities:** Facilitate internship and placement opportunities for IIHMR University's postgraduate students, enabling them to gain practical exposure and strengthen their professional competencies.
- c) **Exposure and Experiential Learning:** Arrange exposure visits for postgraduate students and training participants to deepen their understanding of hospital operations, management practices, and patient care systems.
- d) **Research and Knowledge Dissemination:** Collaborate on the development and publication of research papers, working papers, case studies, and policy briefs that contribute to evidence-based healthcare management.
- e) **Industry-Academia Interface:** Encourage hospital leaders and experts to deliver guest lectures, conduct practice-oriented sessions, and mentor students to bridge the gap between academic learning and real-world healthcare delivery.

- f) **Research Access with Confidentiality:** Permit PhD scholars and researchers from IIHMR University to undertake research utilizing relevant hospital data, subject to prior approval and strict adherence to data privacy, ethical standards, and confidentiality requirements.
- g) **Future Collaboration:** Identify and pursue additional areas of cooperation in education, training, research, and consultancy as may be mutually agreed upon from time to time.

4. Financial Arrangements

This MoU will not give rise to any financial obligation by one Party to the other. Each Party will bear its own costs and expenses in implementing this MoU.

5. Confidentiality

Each Party shall always maintain the utmost confidentiality regarding the contents of this MoU, and no Party shall use or disclose any confidential information of the other Party for any other purpose.

6. Force Majeure

Both Parties shall not be responsible for any failure to perform due to unforeseen circumstances or causes beyond their reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of nature, war, riots, embargoes, acts of civil or military authorities, fire, floods, accidents, terrorist acts, strikes, or shortages of transportation, facilities, fuel, energy, labor, or materials. If any such aspect is beyond the control of participating agencies, appropriate strategies would be worked out to compensate for the activities/ schedules accordingly.

7. Liability

Both Parties shall be solely liable for any damages/claims against them in connection with the exercise of the objectives of this MoU hereunder unless both parties agree otherwise. Liability for specific activities jointly undertaken by parties shall be referred to in the specific agreements executed.

8. Duration

The MoU would be effective for three years from the date of its execution (i.e., signing by both parties). It may be extended after the expiry of three years on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon.

9. Termination

Either Party may terminate this MoU by written notice for 30 days without prejudice to any other remedy for any breach of the MoU.

10. Amendments

- Either Party may request in writing a revision, amendment or modification of all or any part of this MoU.

- Any revision, amendment or modification agreed to between the Parties shall be in writing and come into force on such date as determined by the Parties and shall form part of this MoU.

11. Conflict of Interest

Both Parties warrant that this MoU is not likely to conflict with any of their organisational, financial, contractual, or other interests relating to the activities under this MoU. Both parties also agree that this MoU will not be treated as a deterrent to allowing similar activities or collaboration with other organisations.

12. Resolution of Disputes

Any dispute arising between the Parties to this MoU will be heard by an Arbitrator who will be appointed after consulting both parties.
