### Refund Policy for MBA program for Admission Year 2021-22

Please find below refund policy of IIHMR University for MBA program for admission year 2021-22. This policy is line with UGC refund policy that is also available on UGC website.

1. Formally notified last date of admission for MBA program is **30<sup>th</sup> June 2021**.
2. Those students who have obtained the admission by making payment towards initial instalments (1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> installment) can avail refund as per the following details:

<b>Sr.</b>	<b>Date of written Refund request received from student</b>	<b>Percentage of Refund of aggregate fees*</b>
1	Up to 15 <sup>th</sup> June 2021	100%
2	From 16 <sup>th</sup> June 2021 to 15 <sup>th</sup> July 2021	80%
3	From 16 <sup>th</sup> July 2021 to 30 <sup>th</sup> July 2021	50%
4	From 1 <sup>st</sup> August 2021 onwards	0%

**\*(Inclusive of course fees and non-tuition fees but exclusive of caution money and security deposit)**

3. Students should send email to [admissions@iihmr.edu.in](mailto:admissions@iihmr.edu.in) for cancellation of admission citing proper reason from his/her registered email id with IIHMR University.
4. In case of 1 in the table above, the HEI concerned shall deduct an amount not more than 10% of the aggregate fees as the processing charges as per UGC Refund policy, but IIHMR University will not deduct any amount as the processing charges.
5. S/He must mention Bank Account No., Bank Name, Branch Name with IFSC Code in the email. Any failure in payment due to improper details will be sole responsibility of the student.
6. Students who have paid hostel fees and canceling their admission prior to occupying hostel accommodation will be paid full refund of the hostel fees.
7. Students who wish to cancel their admission to hostel after occupying hostel accommodation will not be liable for any refund of hostel fees.
8. If UGC announce any other fresh guidelines regarding refund for the year 2021-22, IIHMR University will be following those guidelines being UGC approved university.
