UNDERTAKING OF IIHMR UNIVERSITY


IIHMR University is closely monitoring the ongoing Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) pandemic. As the situation continues to change rapidly, our top priority remains the health, safety, and well-being of our students, faculties, employees on and off campus. We are planning for several contingency scenarios and taking decisive, informed action to limit the spread of COVID-19 while ensuring the continuity of our teaching and research mission. The University remains open and operational with appropriate measures to protect the health of the community.

The University has taken necessary precautions and following as per the advisory of University Grants Commission (UGC) to prevention/reduction of the spread of the virus.

Following are the precautions taken:

- Evaded large gatherings in the campus like Holi Celebrations with Colors & cancelled scheduled programs.
- Admission process has been stopped until further notice.
- All international and non-essential domestic travel of staffs, students & faculties has been suspended.
- Staffs with travels history to Covid-19 affected places or in contact with such persons are informed to the Director General of Health Departments to monitor them & allotted to work from home.
- Awareness programs has been organized by Dr. DK. Mangal towards taking precautions to prevent COVID-19 for Faculties & Employees.
- Orientation class was conducted for students to take precautions against COVID-19 by Dr.D K Mangal.
- 50nos of precaution notice poster has been placed all over the campus.

CLEANING /DISINFECTING ALL THE AREAS

Hygienic Hard Surface Cleaner (**Product Name: SATOL S2**) Regular cleaning of the frequently touching spaces like doorknobs, furniture's, desktops, switches, hand railings of the University will help to keep your staff & students healthy and well, by preventing the spread of nasty infections or virus through the knobs . All the washrooms and building premises are mopping 3 times in a day and changing of dustbin garbage bags daily.

Foot operated pedal dustbins are placed all over the campus with plastic bags.



- Visiting Doctor's schedule has been changed to all the days in a week until Covid-19 will be controlled or sterilized. Students are regularly informed and monitored as if there any symptoms may founded.
- Fumigation is performed after every 15 days in Hostel, Housing & Club House areas.
- Vacuum up & shampooing the chairs are performed every 10 days.
- Cleaning of the Outer Area.






STERIFUMING SERVICE


