

OBJECTIVES OF FDP SESSION


- To talk about and exchange views on entrepreneurship and entrepreneurship development, specially for IIHMR students.

WHAT IS ENTREPRENEURSHIP


- Entrepreneurship is taking an idea and turning it into a sustainable business

COMPONENTS OF ENTREPRENEURIAL MINDSET




ENTREPRENEURSHIP IN HIGHER EDUCATION (HHE)

- Entrepreneurs are made rather than born
- Characteristics and experiences render an individual more disposed to the path of entrepreneurship
- Aim of HHE is to help students develop an entrepreneurial mindset
- HHE gives you an expanded horizon and backup to switch to other options
- Age Range: 17-25 yrs : Transitional stage : Adults : They are capable of using symbols and relate them to abstract thinking.

SKILL BASED HHE

- Entrepreneurship is as much a science as it is an art
- Skill based learning rather than degree based learning
- Everyone can learn to be creative. 2/3rd or 67% of creativity skills are developed through learning
- Skill based HHE helps in analyzing multiple variables in systematic manner and apply them in real life situations.
- Skill based HHE helps in solving problems and taking creative strategic decisions based on valid and reliable data.
- Result : business will operate with high accountability and business will be sustainable.
