INTRODUCTION: The session, led by Mr. Prabal Mukherjee, focused on the theme "Public Health and Global Health Challenges." The discussion provided a comprehensive overview of the core principles of public health, differentiating its population-level focus from individual-level clinical care. Mr. Mukherjee, drawing from his experience as a Public Health Consultant at the World Bank, shed light on the most pressing global health issues, including non-communicable and infectious diseases, antimicrobial resistance, and mental health. The session emphasized the importance of a multidisciplinary approach, combining data-driven planning, policy advocacy, and community engagement to build resilient and equitable healthcare systems for the future.

OBJECTIVE:

The primary objectives of the session were:

- To define public health and differentiate between the roles of a public health professional and a clinician.
- To emphasize the importance of preventive and promotive health in improving quality of life and reducing healthcare costs.
- To align public health challenges with the UN's Sustainable Development Goal 3 (Good Health and Well-being).
- To highlight critical global health challenges such as non-communicable diseases, pandemics, antimicrobial resistance (AMR), and mental health.
- To discuss systemic issues like health inequalities, the impact of climate change on health, and the inefficiencies within healthcare delivery systems.
- To explore strategic approaches for disease prevention and addressing broader population health through data, community engagement, and policy advocacy.
- To introduce key global health initiatives and recommendations, including the "One Health" approach and the implementation of a unique health ID.

Salient Novel Points Covered:

ROLE: Mr. Prabal Mukherjee has built a distinguished career in public health, with a trajectory that has taken him from state-level program implementation to shaping global health policy. He began his professional journey with the **National Health Mission (NHM) in Gujarat**, contributing to vital grassroots health initiatives. Building on this foundational experience, he took on roles of increasing responsibility within national health agencies, focusing on policy and large-scale program management. This path eventually led him to the international arena, and he currently serves as a **Public Health Consultant at the World Bank**, where he advises on complex global health challenges and strategies.

KEY TAKEAWAY POINTS FROM THE SESSION:

- **Integrated Expertise:** Hospital administration requires a blend of clinical understanding and managerial skills to run healthcare systems sustainably.

- **Financial Literacy:** Knowledge of cost structures, financial ratios, and balance sheets is essential for effective hospital management.
- **Technology Integration: AI and analytics** are becoming central to hospital operations, efficiency, and financial planning.
- Consultancy Roles: Consultancy is a viable career path that demands strong analytical and problem-solving skills.
- **Professional Growth:** Mentorship, networking, and continuous learning are key factors in shaping a successful career in hospital administration.
- **Multidisciplinary Approach:** Modern healthcare demands a combination of healthcare knowledge, business acumen, and technological adaptability.

Q&A and Interactive Session: The session concluded with an engaging Q&A segment where students posed a range of insightful questions. A key query focused on the intersection of global trade and public health, with a student asking about the role of leading organizations, like the World Bank, in addressing the impact of trade tariffs imposed by the U.S. on medical supplies and health systems. Other questions centered on the practical implementation of the "One Health" approach, career opportunities in global public health, and strategies to combat health inequalities in developing nations. Mr. Mukherjee provided detailed answers, encouraging students to think critically and pursue careers where they can contribute to building stronger, more equitable health systems globally.
