- Value-Based Pricing: Links drug pricing to measurable patient outcomes and overall value.
- Q&A and Interactive Session: The session encouraged active participation from students, who not only
 clarified their conceptual doubts about the market access in pharmaceutical industry, but also asked relevant
 questions about how to co-relate value-based pricing and significance of QALY in the pharmaceutical industry
 and progress further in their career.
