3. **Early Bird Discount:** Nominations received with payment on or before one month from the commencement date of the MDP will be entitled to an Early Bird Discount of 10%.
4. **Group Discount:** Any organisation sponsoring four or more participants to an MDP will be entitled to a group discount of 20% on the total fee payable, provided that at least four participants attend the MDP.
5. Organisations can avail themselves of both discounts, subject to a maximum discount of 20%.
6. Brochures for each programme will be available two months before the programme commences.
7. The programme dates mentioned may undergo changes.
