Background

Upkeep and maintenance of critical equipment, supply chain management, healthcare waste management, quality assurance, patient safety and accreditation are the buzz word in health sector. Moreover, a modern hospital is labor intensive organization that involves huge expenses (both capex and opex). As a rule of thumb, we need to have a minimum of 2.5 employees per bed in a modern multispecialty hospital. The country is also facing an acute shortage of qualified, experienced, and trained hospital administrators. In such a scenario it becomes essential to focus on capacity building and training of the existing staff, aspiring to work as managers or heading the hospitals together with senior nurses and midlevel doctors and others in hospital management.

- ◆ To equip participants with the knowledge and skills for management, as well as understanding the legal aspects of medical care.
