The programme will provide the participants with the tools and techniques for effectively managing the supply chain of vaccines, with an added focus on cold chain management, thus ensuring the safety of the vaccines. They will be exposed to real situations to help them find practical solutions and implement them in their own settings

# Certificate


A certificate of participation on completion of the programme will be issued by IIHMR University, Jaipur.
