National Health Systems Resource Centre (NHSRC)

IIHMR University, Jaipur, entered an MoU with NHSRC, New Delhi, to establish continuing collaboration by identifying and developing areas of cooperation in education and research. The collaboration includes joint academic activities, collaborative research projects, seminars/lectures, exchange of publications and academic information, and exchange of faculty/students for collaborative work. The MoU is non-committal in terms of automatic financial/personnel support; specific activities are to be supported based on the availability of resources and applicable policies.
