

About the MoU

CK Birla Hospitals (CMRI / Rukmani Birla Hospital, Jaipur)

IIHMR University, Jaipur, entered an MoU with The Calcutta Medical Research Institute (CMRI), a public charitable trust, for its unit Rukmani Birla Hospital (RBH/CK Birla Hospitals, Jaipur). The MoU establishes an academic-industry partnership to facilitate student internships, dissertations, practicums and exposure visits at RBH, enabling hospital-based research and joint academic activities such as workshops, seminars and training programmes. The collaboration supports experiential learning for IIHMR students and aims to contribute to hospital efficiency and healthcare management practices through structured academic engagement.

2. MoU Details

- **Parties:** IIHMR University, Jaipur (First Party) and CMRI for its unit Rukmani Birla Hospital / CK Birla Hospitals, Jaipur (Second Party).
- **MoU Start Date:** 04 January 2023
- **MoU End Date:** 03 January 2026 (3 years from execution; extendable by mutual consent)
- **Duration:** Three (3) years from execution; extendable by mutual consent.
- **Scope:** Internship/dissertation/practicum opportunities; exposure visits; hospital-based doctoral research; joint research proposals/papers; workshops/conferences/seminars/training programmes.
- **Confidentiality:** Both parties and participating students/researchers must maintain confidentiality, including patient-sensitive information and non-public institutional information.

3. Activities Conducted under the MoU

1. Activity 1: Health Talk on Women's Health (International Women's Day special)

Date & Duration: 01 March 2024 | 1 hour. Venue: Old Auditorium, IIHMR University, Jaipur. The session was organised by IIHMR University, Jaipur, in collaboration with CK Birla Hospitals, Jaipur. The talk was delivered by Dr. Anukriti Sood, Consultant (Breast and Endocrine Surgery), CK Birla Hospitals, Jaipur. Key focus areas included women's health awareness, the importance of regular check-ups, preventive measures, early detection of diseases, and breast cancer awareness, including the role of mammograms in early detection and improved treatment outcomes.

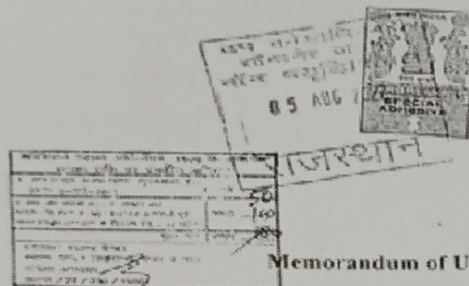

Sodani**, President hereinafter referred to as the "**First Party**", which term unless repugnant to the context thereof shall mean and include its legal heirs, successors, nominees and permitted assigns, etc.).

AND

The Calcutta Medical Research Institute, a Public Charitable Trust, having its office at 772, Diamond Harbour Road, Alipore, Kolkata - 700027 for its unit **Rukmani Birla Hospital**, situated at Gopalpura Bypass Road, Jaipur-302018, represented by its Authorized Signatory, **Mr. Anubhav Sukhwani**, Unit Head, hereinafter referred to as the "**CMRI**" (hereinafter referred to as the "**Second Party**", which term unless repugnant to the context thereof shall mean and include its successors and permitted assigns).

(**IIHMR University** and **CMRI** shall thereafter be collectively referred to as "**Parties**" and individually as "**Party**".)

1. WHEREAS:

- A. **IIHMR University, Jaipur** (First Party) dates to October 5, 1984, when the Indian Institute of Health Management Research (IIHMR) was established. The IIHMR University has been established and incorporated as a postgraduate research University by the Government of Rajasthan vide the IIHMR University, Jaipur Act, 2014 (Act No. 3, of 2014). IIHMR University is UGC recognized, NAAC accredited, and ranked 73rd NIRF 2021 (Management). IIHMR University is dedicated to the improvement in standards of health through better management of health care and related programs. It seeks to accomplish this through management research, education, training, consultation, and networking in a national and global perspective. IIHMR University offers MBA (Hospital and Health Management), MBA (Pharmaceutical Management), MBA (Development Management), Master of Public Health (in collaboration with Johns Hopkins University, USA), Master of public Health (Implementation Science), Executive Education, and PhD programs. The First Party have collaborations with international and prestigious universities including Johns Hopkins university, USA, Manchester University, UK, Curtin University, Australia for student exchange, faculty exchange, joint research and capacity building programs.

11. Resolution of Disputes

In the event of any dispute regarding any provisions of this MoU, the same shall, at first instance be amicably settled between the parties. If any dispute is not settled amicably the same shall be referred to the Sole Arbitrator, that to be appointed mutually. The award given by the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties.

12. Intellectual Property Rights

Intellectual property and all other proprietary rights will have the broadest possible meaning for the purpose of this Agreement and include, without limitation, all patent rights, copyrights, trademarks, all auxiliary rights relating to the protection of trade secrets and confidential information, and any right similar to any of the foregoing in any and all forms, format and media whether in existence now or which may arise in future, for perpetuity and the entire territory of the world. (IPR).

Parties shall not use or allow any employee, agent or third party to use or exploit the other party's trademarks or copyright or patent or design or any other intellectual property rights (including publicity material) without the prior written permission of the sharing party. The Trademark, logo, brand name, domain name, intellectual property owned and used by the Party shall belong to such Party at all times and nothing contained herein grants any other right, title or interest to the other Party with respect to such Trademark, logo, brand name, domain name, intellectual property at anytime whatsoever.

13. Governing Law / Jurisdiction

The applicable law governing this Agreement shall be the laws of India and only the courts of Jaipur shall have the exclusive jurisdiction to try any dispute with respect of this MoU.

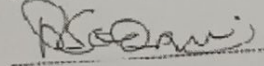
14. Two Counterparts

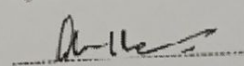

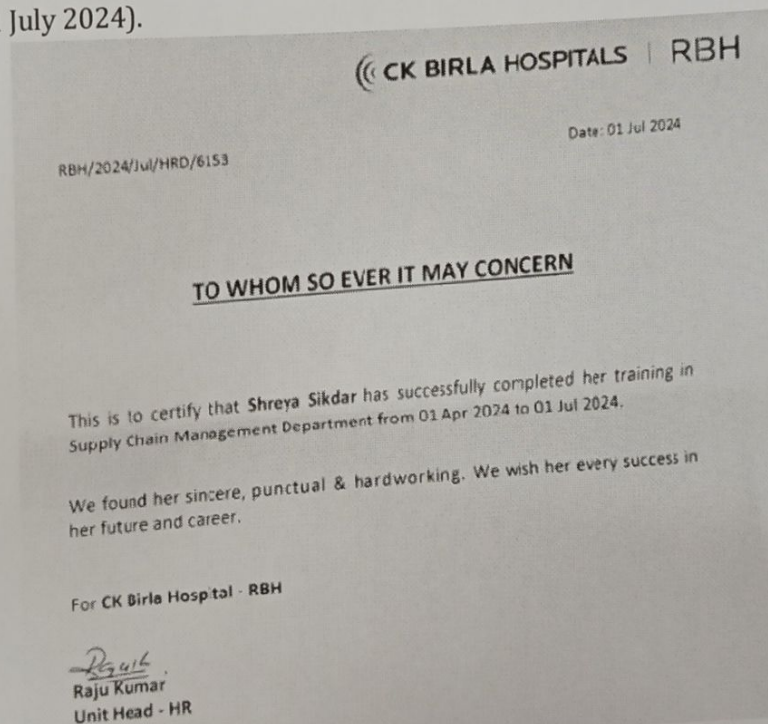
