

About the MoU

Curtin University, Malaysia

IIHMR University, Jaipur, entered a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Curtin University, Malaysia, to establish a framework for academic cooperation. The MoU promotes collaboration through student and staff exchange, joint research and innovation activities, joint capacity-building programmes (seminars, conferences, public lectures), joint publications, reciprocal participation in doctoral and research programmes, and quality assurance/benchmarking initiatives.

2. MoU Details

- **Parties:** Curtin University, Malaysia and IIHMR University, Jaipur, India.
- **MoU Document Year:** 2024
- **MoU Start Date:** 23 April 2024
- **MoU End Date:** 22 April 2029, Five (5) years from the date of signing (renewable/extendable by mutual consent).
- **Nature of MoU:** Non-legally binding MoU (expression of intentions); each party bears its own costs.
- **Key Areas of Cooperation:** Student & staff exchanges; joint research & innovation; joint seminars/conferences/public lectures; joint publications; doctoral/research collaboration; benchmarking and resource/expertise sharing.
- **Termination:** Either party may terminate with a minimum of two (2) months' written notice; activities in progress may conclude as planned unless otherwise agreed.

3. Activities Conducted under the MoU

1. Activity 1: Academic Participation and Recognition at GlobeCoReS 2024 (Curtin University, Malaysia)

Ms. Kirti Agarwal (IIHMR University) received the Best Presenter Award at the GlobeSync Community Research and Sustainability Conference 2024 (GlobeCoReS 2024), hosted by Curtin University, Malaysia, held from 3–6 September 2024. Her presentation titled “Preparedness of Health Facilities to Provide Healthcare Services to the Transgender Community: Results from a Study in Rajasthan, India” was recognised under the theme of inclusive health and sustainable communities.

2. Activity 2: Academic Engagement during IIHMR University Conference 2025 (Pradanya 2025 – GHMRC 2025)

During Pradanya 2025: Global Health Management Research Conference (GHMRC 2025) held on 14–15 February 2025 at IIHMR University, Jaipur, Curtin University, Malaysia, participated as an academic collaborator through expert engagement. The programme schedule records Prof. Roy Rillera Marzo (Curtin University, Malaysia) as a panellist in the Day 2 panel discussion on the

BETWEEN

CURTIN UNIVERSITY MALAYSIA, incorporated as a University pursuant to the Private Higher Educational Institutions Act 1996 Registration No. KPT/IPT/DFT/UIS/Y02 DULN003(O), owned and managed by Curtin (Malaysia) Sdn Bhd Company Registration No. 199801008086 (464213-M), a company incorporated and registered under the Companies Act, 2016 in Malaysia with its registered address at Lot 12732, Block 5 Kuala Baram Land District, Lutong, CDT 250, 98009 Miri, Sarawak, Malaysia (hereinafter referred to as "Curtin") of the one part;

AND

IIHMR University, Jaipur, India, has been established and incorporated as a postgraduate research University by the Government of Rajasthan vide the IIHMR University Ordinance, 2013 (Ordinance No. 30 of 2013) promulgated on September 27, 2013, by the Governor, which was replaced by the IIHMR University, Jaipur Act, 2014 (Act No. 3 of 2014) passed by the State Legislature on February 07, 2014. The IIHMR University Act 2014 (Act No. 3 of 2014) received the assent of the Governor on the 25th day of February 2014 and was notified in the Rajasthan Gazette-Extraordinary on February 26, 2014. It has been deemed to have come into force on and from September 27, 2013. The University is situated and has its headquarters at 1 Prabhu Dayal Marg, Near Sanganer Airport, Tehsil Sanganer, District Jaipur, Rajasthan, India.

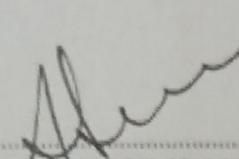
(Both Curtin and IIHMR University shall hereinafter be referred to singularly as "the Party" and collectively as "the Parties")

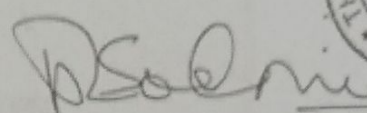

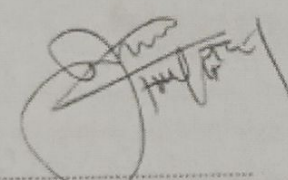

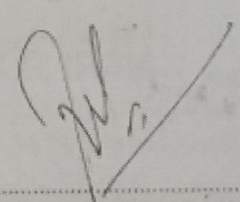
