IPE Global Limited / IPE-CKD (Arogya Dadri)

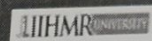
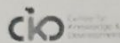
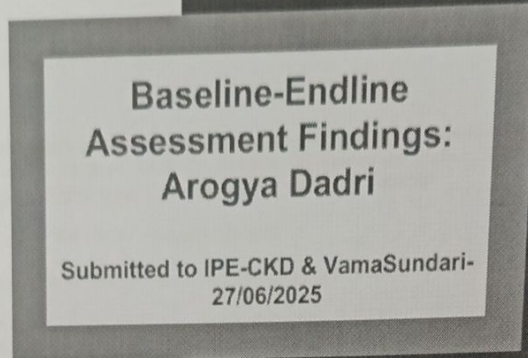
IIHMR University, Jaipur, entered a MoU with IPE Global Limited to establish a framework for sustained collaboration in Research, Training, Academics and Consultancy. The MoU supports joint research proposals and publications, organization of trainings/workshops/conferences/seminars/webinars, student internships and practicums, exposure visits, and exploration of project-based data use for doctoral research, subject to the availability of opportunities and selection on merit.

2. MoU Details

- **Parties:** IIHMR University, Jaipur and IPE Global Limited, New Delhi.
- **MoU Signing / Execution Date:** 13 August 2024
- **MoU Start Date:** 13 August 2024 (date of execution/signing).
- **MoU End Date (as per duration clause):** 12 August 2027 (three years from execution; extendable by mutual consent).
- **Nature of MoU:** Non-financial framework MoU; each party bears its own costs.
- **Key Collaboration Areas:** Research & academic collaboration; internships/dissertations/practicums; exposure visits; joint training and events; potential placement opportunities (subject to availability).

Note: The MoU text includes an internal inconsistency in the validity statement (mentions three years and separately indicates validity "until one year after the date of execution"). For institutional reporting, the three-year duration from execution is used as the primary term, consistent with the stated "effective for a period of three years".

3. Activity / Project Evidence under Collaboration: “Arogya Dadri” (Service Agreement with IPE-CKD)



As evidence of collaboration, IIHMR University entered into a Service Agreement/Contract with IPE Global Centre for Knowledge and Development (CKD) as the implementing agency for the “Arogya Dadri” project. The project is a community-centred health program focusing on Maternal & Child Health (MCH) and Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) in approximately 20 villages of Dadri Block, Gautam Buddha Nagar, Uttar Pradesh, using an HWC-centric and community-based approach.

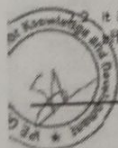
1. COMMENCEMENT AND TENURE OF CONTRACT

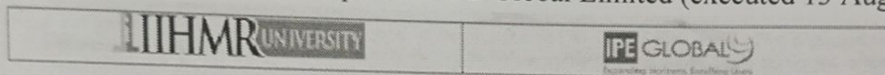
4. Key Outputs / Outcomes (Baseline–Endline Findings Snapshot)

Selected results from the submitted findings presentation indicate improvements in awareness and screening for NCDs, and strengthened MCH service awareness and practices:

- Awareness of causes of NCDs increased from 49% (baseline) to 82% (endline).
- Screening for diabetes/hypertension in the last 3 months increased from 37% (baseline) to 80% (endline).
- Awareness of VHSND increased from 60% (baseline) to 85% (endline), and attendance increased from 47% to 75%.
- Awareness of early ANC registration timing increased from 80% (baseline) to 92% (endline); ANC registration increased from 90% to 97%.

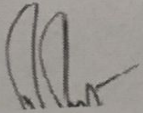
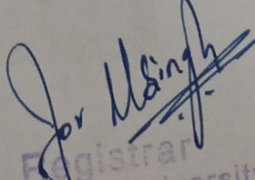
1. Partner Background
