Bhagwan Mahaveer Cancer Hospital & Research Centre (BMCHRC)

IIHMR University, Jaipur and Bhagwan Mahaveer Cancer Hospital & Research Centre (BMCHRC) entered a Memorandum of Understanding to establish a framework for collaboration in research, training, academics, consultancy, and student engagement. BMCHRC is a 300-bedded, NABH-accredited, not-for-profit super-speciality cancer hospital providing world-class cancer care. The MoU enables joint research projects, training and capacity-building programmes, internships, dissertations, exposure visits, and potential placement opportunities for IIHMR University students.

2. MoU Details

- **Parties:** IIHMR University, Jaipur and Bhagwan Mahaveer Cancer Hospital & Research Centre (BMCHRC), Jaipur.
- **MoU Signing Date:** 14 February 2025

- **MoU End Date:** 13 February 2028 (three years from execution; extendable by mutual consent).
- **Nature of MoU:** Non-financial collaborative MoU; each party bears its own costs.

3. Activities Undertaken under the MoU

1. Activity 1: Student Internship at BMCHRC

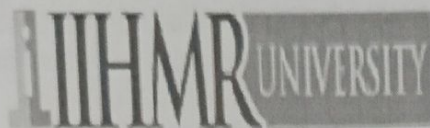
As part of the student engagement provisions of the MoU, IIHMR University students have undertaken internships at BMCHRC. Ms. Bhavya Saxena, a student of IIHMR University, completed her internship in the Human Resource Department at BMCHRC from 11 June 2025 to 29 July 2025. Her performance during the internship period was reported to be satisfactory, demonstrating effective academic-practice linkage under the MoU.

2. Activity 2: Research Consultancy – Situational Analysis for Establishment of Health Centre

BMCHRC (through K.G. Kothari Charitable Trust) approved IIHMR University's proposal titled "Situational Analysis for Establishment of Health Centre" for the Nahargarh area, Jaipur. The approved scope included assessment of existing health problems, service needs, accessibility, challenges in accessing quality healthcare, perceived benefits of a proposed health centre, and availability of pharmacy and medical stores in the area. This activity reflects research and consultancy collaboration envisaged under the MoU.

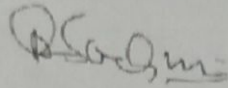
About IIHMR University, Jaipur
