University of Public Health (UPH), Yangon, Myanmar

IIHMR University, Jaipur and the University of Public Health (UPH), Yangon entered into a collaborative MoU to strengthen cooperation in Research, Training, Academics and Consultancy. The MoU supports joint research proposals and publications, co-hosted academic events (trainings, workshops, conferences, seminars, webinars, joint academic and certificate programmes), student and scholar engagement (internships, dissertations, practicums and exposure visits), and exploration of project-based data use for doctoral research, subject to mutual agreement and SOPs of both institutions.

UPH Yangon is a postgraduate public health institution established in July 2007, with a mission to develop leaders and managers in the health sector through education, research, and practice. The Rector, Prof. Dr. Hla Hla Win, has served as Rector since 2019 with extensive experience in public health teaching and research (MNCH, NCDs, elderly health and mental health).

- **Parties:** IIHMR University, Jaipur (India) and University of Public Health (UPH), Yangon (Myanmar).
- **MoU Start Date:** 14 February 2025
- **MoU End Date:** 13 February 2030 (five years from execution; extendable by mutual consent)

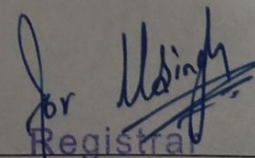
3. Activities Undertaken under the MoU (Evidence)

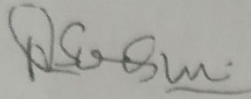
About IIHMR University, Jaipur
