INTRODUCTION: The Master Class 145 session titled “Masterclass on Global Health ” was held on December 29, 2025 , at IIHMR University in offline mode. The session was moderated by Dr. Ram Krishan Chahar , Assistant Professor, SD Gupta School of Public Health. The guest speaker Dr Sanjiv Kumar is a Professor of Leadership and Global Health at the INCLEN Institute of Global Health.
OBJECTIVE: The objective is to understand Global Health, Global–Local Linkages in Health System and Leadership in Global Health.
SALIENT NOVEL POINTS COVERED 1. Understanding Global Health The session began with an overview of the concept of global health, emphasizing that it extends beyond traditional international health by addressing health issues that transcend national boundaries. Global health was framed as a shared responsibility that requires collective action across countries and systems. Key discussions highlighted how global determinants such as migration, climate change, trade, pandemics, and geopolitics directly influence national and local health outcomes. The session underscored that health challenges are increasingly interconnected, making coordinated global responses essential. 2. Global–Local Linkages and Health Systems The session explored the dynamic relationship between global events and local health systems. Recent global health emergencies, particularly pandemics, were used to demonstrate how global crises rapidly place pressure on local healthcare infrastructure. Key points included: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The importance of preparedness and resilience in health systems.• The need for adaptive systems capable of responding to evolving global threats.• Challenges in translating global evidence into local policy and practice, especially within low- and middle-income countries (LMICs).

This section emphasized the importance of strengthening health systems to respond effectively to both global and local health demands.

3. Leadership in Global Health

Leadership was identified as a critical driver of effective global health action. The discussion highlighted several core leadership attributes essential for addressing complex health challenges:

- Strategic thinking
- Evidence-informed decision-making
- Ethical leadership and accountability
- Ability to collaborate across sectors and disciplines

The role of leadership during crises was emphasized, particularly in managing uncertainty, ensuring clear communication, and coordinating multi-sectoral responses. A strong example discussed was the role of high-level political commitment—such as the Prime Minister of India’s leadership in driving national efforts toward tuberculosis elimination.

4. Reflections for Students and Future Professionals

The session concluded with reflections aimed at students and emerging health professionals. Participants were encouraged to view themselves as future leaders operating within interconnected global health systems rather than isolated institutions.

Key takeaways included:

- The importance of systems thinking in health management.
- The need for continuous learning and global awareness.
- Understanding that leadership in health is not solely position-based but is demonstrated through responsibility, initiative, and action.

This perspective reinforced the idea that effective global health leadership can emerge at all levels of the health system.

Q&A and Interactive Session: The session concluded with an engaging and interactive Q&A segment, during which students actively participated by raising questions related to the practical application of global health concepts.

Conclusion: The Masterclass on Global Health highlighted the importance of interconnected health systems, strong leadership, and evidence-based decision-making in addressing global health challenges. It emphasized the need for adaptability, systems thinking, and collaboration to translate global knowledge into effective local action. The session encouraged participants to see themselves as future leaders contributing to resilient and equitable health systems.

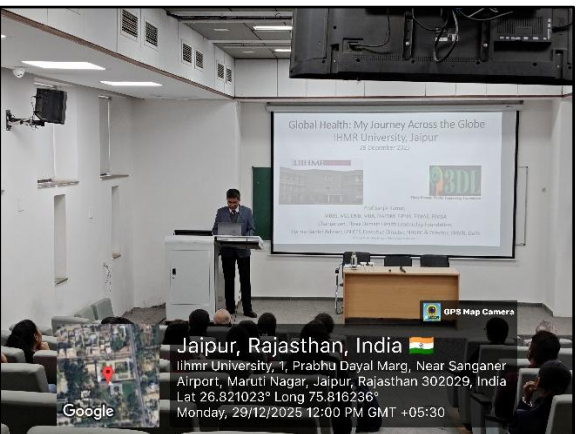

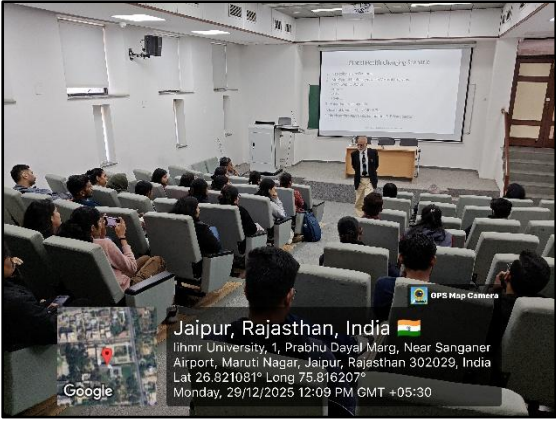
