



Net Zero Commitment (Target: 2036)

Commitment

IIHMR University commits to achieving Net Zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2036, by systematically reducing emissions across campus operations and addressing residual emissions through credible measures.

Scope: The Net Zero target covers Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions. Scope 3 emissions shall be measured, disclosed, and progressively reduced.

Roadmap

The University shall adopt the following structured approach:

- 1. Reduce Energy Demand**
Improve energy conservation through awareness, behavioural change, and smart controls such as sensors and automation.
- 2. Enhance Energy Efficiency**
Upgrade to high-efficiency systems including LED lighting and 5-star rated equipment.
- 3. Reduce Fossil Fuel Use**
Transition from fossil fuel-based systems to electric alternatives, including campus vehicles and equipment.
- 4. Adopt Clean Energy**
Increase the share of renewable energy through on-site and off-site sources, targeting 80% renewable energy by 2036.
- 5. Address Residual Emissions**
Neutralize remaining emissions through carbon sequestration and credible offset mechanisms.

Monitoring and Review

Progress shall be monitored annually through defined indicators and reviewed periodically to ensure alignment with the Net Zero target.
