# 1. About the University

## Origin

The genesis of the IIHMR University, Jaipur dates back to October 05, 1984, when its sponsoring body, the Indian Institute of Health Management Research (IIHMR) was established and registered as a non-profit Society under the Rajasthan Societies Registration Act, 1958. IIHMR University, Jaipur, has been established and incorporated as a postgraduate research University by the Government of Rajasthan vide the IIHMR University Ordinance, 2013 (Ordinance No. 30 of 2013) promulgated on September 27, 2013, by the Governor, which was replaced by the IIHMR University, Jaipur Act, 2014 (Act No. 3 of 2014) passed by the State Legislature on February 07, 2014. The IIHMR University, Jaipur Act, 2014 (Act No. 3 of 2014) received the assent of the Governor on February 25, 2014, and was notified in the Rajasthan Gazette Extraordinary on February 26, 2014. It has been deemed to have come into force on and from September 27, 2013.

## Objectives of the University

As defined in Section 4 of the IIHMR University, Jaipur Act, 2014, the objects of the University shall be to undertake only postgraduate education and research in the disciplines specified in Schedule II and such other disciplines as the University may with prior approval of the State Government, determine from time to time and to achieve excellence and impart and disseminate knowledge in the said disciplines. 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## 5. Education

IIHMR University offers the following post-graduate and doctoral programmes:

### Post-Graduate Programmes

**MBA (Hospital and Health Management):** A two-year full-time programme offered by IIHMR University under the Institute of Health Management Research. The total number of students admitted in the academic session 2023-25 was 229 (165 Female; 64 Male). The programme aims to develop leaders and managers for the health sector with requisite competencies and skill sets in planning, implementation, operations management, and problem-solving in healthcare delivery systems and hospitals.

**MBA (Pharmaceutical Management):** A two-year full-time programme offered by IIHMR University under the School of Pharmaceutical Management. The total number of students admitted in the academic session 2023-25 was 126 (50 Female; 76 Male). The programme aims to develop professional leaders and managers with requisite competencies and skills in solving managerial problems in the pharmaceutical industry.

**MBA (Development Management):** A two-year full-time programme offered by IIHMR University under the School of Development Studies. The total number of students admitted in the academic session 2023-25 was 12 (2 Female; 10 Male). The programme aims to develop professional leaders and managers with requisite competencies and skills in solving managerial problems of the development sector.

**MBA (Healthcare Analytics):** A two-year full-time programme offered by IIHMR University under School of Digital Health. The first batch is set to commence in 2024 - 2025. The programme aims to develop professional leaders and managers with requisite competencies and skills in solving managerial problems in the healthcare management and analytics.

**Master of Public Health:** A two-year full-time programme offered by Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health, Baltimore, USA, in cooperation with IIHMR University, placed under the S.D. Gupta School of Public Health. The total number of students admitted in the academic session 2023-25 was 4 (3 Female; 1 Male). The programme aims to develop leaders and managers for public health with requisite competencies and skill sets in epidemiology, biostatistics, management, and social sciences.

**Master of Public Health (Implementation Science) :** IIHMR University got selected globally for second phase of WHO-TDR post Graduate Training scholarships for a two-year MPH Programme with specialisation in Implementation Research. The total number of students admitted in the academic session 2023-25 was 14 (5 Female; 9 Male).

### ***Leadership Certification Programme for Community Health Officers***

*IIHMR University signed MoU with NISHTHA/Jhpiego, to conduct the "Leadership Certification Programme for Community Health Officer", a 10-week online course spanning 40 hours and encompassing 7 modules to train selected CHOs from 14 states of India in 13 cohorts. The program aimed to enhance the capabilities of Community Health Workers (CHOs) in managing Health and Wellness Centre to provide quality primary health care services. In total, 1275 CHOs from 14 states had received online training under this program. 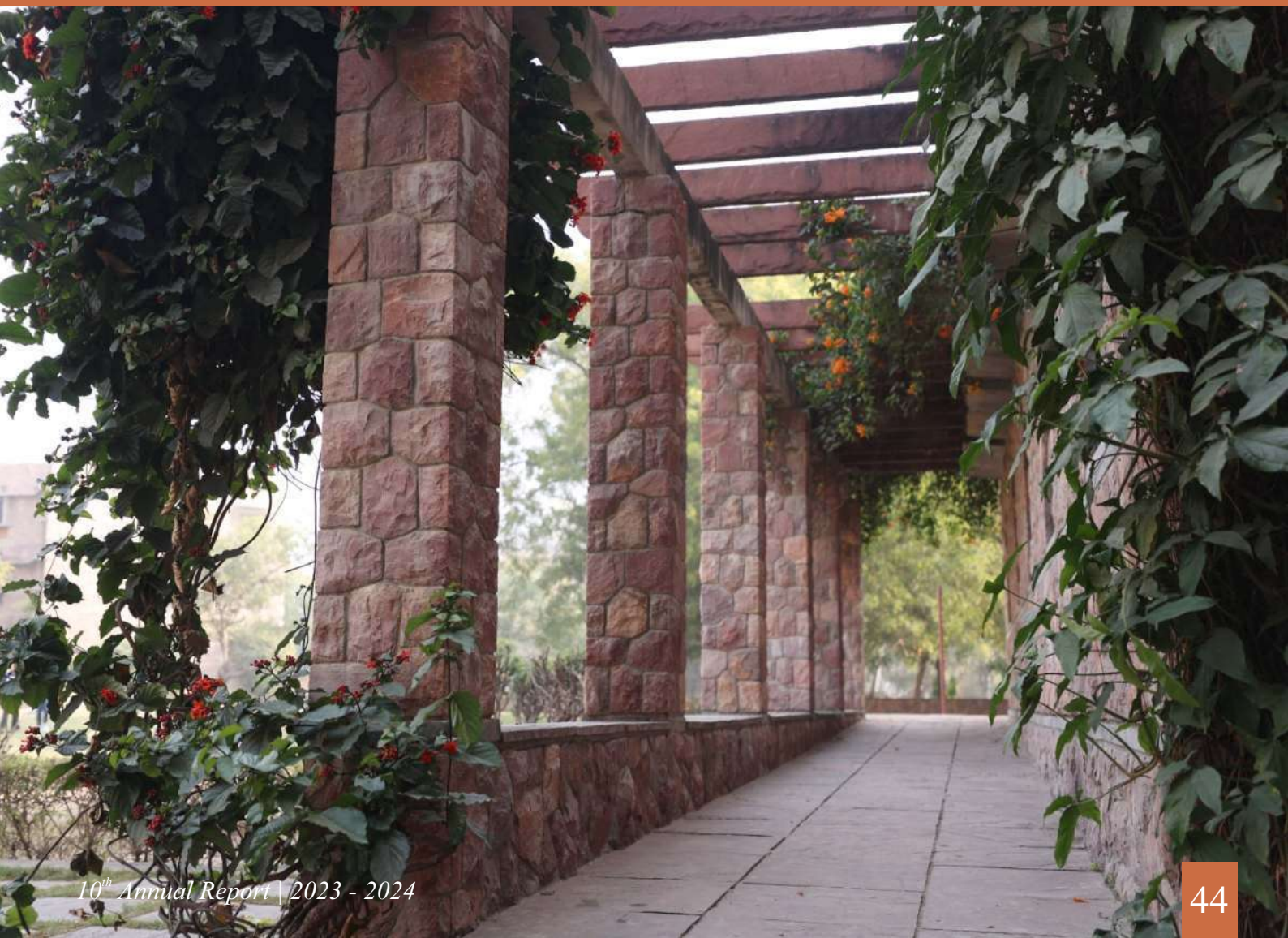

## 14. Financial Systems

The University is an autonomous incorporated body. In pursuance of section 6 of The IIHMR University, Jaipur Act, 2014, the University manages its finances through its resources like research projects, educational programmes, and training. The University is a self-financed organization and does not receive any grant or other financial assistance from the State Government.

### Accounting and Financial Procedures

IIHMR University has approved Accounting and Financial Procedures, and all activities and tasks of the Finance and Accounts Department are performed in accordance with the Accounting and Financial Procedures. There are adequate checks and balances to insulate the organization from misappropriation and misuse of financial resources. The accounting procedures adequately provide efficient management of university funds and assets. The procedures also manifestly depict the responsibilities of persons managing the finance and budget. The Finance and Accounts Department adheres to the university's accounting procedures.

### Annual Budgeting

The University prepares its Annual Budget every year. For the Financial Year 2023-24, the Annual Budget has been prepared based on a participatory process involving the Registrar, Deans, Faculty Members, and Heads of Department (Administration, Finance, IT, Library, etc.). Each administrative and academic vertical conducted detailed assessments of the enabling and mitigating factors that are likely to shape the coming financial year's budgetary projections. The result is the proposed budget. The separate budgeting of the schools has brought more accountability and awareness about the resource generation at the school-level. This exercise will strengthen the self-sustaining character of the University.

**Schedule 'B' of Significant Accounting Policies and Notes forming part of Accounts for the year ending 31/03/2024**

**1. Method of Accounting**

The method of accounting followed by the University is the accrual system of accounting.

**2. Fixed Assets**

The gross block of fixed assets is shown at the cost of acquisition.

**3. Investments**

Investments are stated at purchase cost. Considering them as long-term investment, no short-term fluctuating deficit/gain has been accounted for.

**4. Depreciation**

Depreciation on fixed assets is provided using the written down value method, as per the rates prescribed in Part-C of Schedule II of the Companies Act, 2013, as amended up to date.

**5. Retirement Benefits to Employees**

The University's liability towards retirement benefits in the form of provident fund, gratuity, and leave encashment is charged to the expenditure account. Out of the total gratuity liability of Rs 1,93,73,193/-, Part Gratuity liability of Rs.1,29,72,783/- is covered by a Group Gratuity Scheme Policy issued by the Life Insurance Corporation of India during the Financial year. Balance liabilities will be covered in due course of time.

6. The IIHMR University is an approved charitable institution by the Commissioner of Income Tax (exemption) u/s 12AA (1)(b) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 vide Provisional Registration Number AAAJI0480NE20214 dated 31/05/2021 up to A.Y. 2026-27.

7. Term loan, Overdraft limit, and Bank Guarantee limit from Kotak Mahindra Bank Ltd as of March 31, 2024, are secured against the first and exclusive charge by way of equitable mortgage of immovable property being Land and Building situated at 1, Prabhu Dayal Marg, Sanganer Airport, 302029, and all existing and future receivables/current assets and movable assets of the IIHMR University.

**8. Contingent Liabilities:**

- a. Local taxes (UDT) amounting to Rs. 79,69,065/- (without penalty) due to date is being contested, and the matter is subjudice. We are hopeful of getting the matter settled in our favor.
- b. Indian Institute of Health Management Research (*Sponsored body of IIHMR University Jaipur*) has applied for a grant of exemption u/s 17(1) of the EPF & Misc. Provisions Act, 1952, in the year 2009, which is still pending. An inquiry u/s 7-A of the EPF & Misc. Provisions Act, 1952 is initiated against Indian Institute of Health Management Research and a provisional liability of Rs. 11,26,15,480/- ascertained and demanded on Indian Institute of Health Management Research, out of which Rs 6,86,11,107/- pertains to old employees of Indian Institute of Health Management Research who were transferred to IIHMR University, Jaipur. Indian Institute of Health Management Research has filed a writ petition before the High Court of Rajasthan, and the demand has been stayed by the EPFO department. We are hopeful of getting the matter settled in favour of Indian Institute of Health Management Research. As such, no provision has been made.
