Provision for Divyangjan (Persons with Disabilities)

(Inclusion, Accessibility & Equity)

Accessible Campus Infrastructure

The University has implemented the following **Divyangjan-friendly physical facilities** across the campus:

- **Wheelchair-Accessible Ramps**

Strategically located ramps with appropriate gradients and handrails enable safe, independent movement across academic blocks and common areas.

- **Lifts with Accessible Entry**

Elevators are installed to facilitate vertical mobility for wheelchair users and persons with reduced mobility, ensuring access to all floors and key facilities.

- **Wheelchair Availability**

Wheelchairs are available on campus to support mobility needs during emergencies or for routine movement when required.

- **Divyangjan-Friendly Toilets**

Specially designed restrooms equipped with grab bars, wider doors, and appropriate fittings ensure dignity, comfort, and safety.

- **Reserved Divyangjan Parking Spaces**

Clearly marked, conveniently located parking areas are reserved for persons with disabilities, enabling safe and hassle-free access to buildings.

- **Health and Wellness Centre (Medical Room)**

An on-campus Health and Wellness Centre provides immediate medical support, with accessibility for Divyangjan users.

- **Admission Policy for Divyangjan (Persons with Disabilities)**

The University ensures inclusive and non-discriminatory admissions by clearly outlining eligibility provisions for Persons with Disabilities (PWD/Divyangjan) in its publicly accessible admission criteria.

- **Disability Support Office:**

The University provides dedicated disability support services to assist Divyangjan students and staff with accessibility needs, accommodations, and guidance, ensuring equal participation in academic and campus life.

- **Mentoring:**

The University provides structured mentoring support to guide Divyangjan students in academic, professional, and personal development, ensuring confidence, inclusion, and equal opportunities for success.

- **Scribe Facility:**

The University provides scribe support for Divyangjan students during examinations as per applicable norms, ensuring equal opportunity and a fair assessment environment.

- **Adequate Funding and Budgetary Support:**
