He called for a collaboration between technology and healthcare to identify and treat diseases more efficiently.

Dr Pankaj Gupta, President, IIHMR University, expressed his gratitude to the founder Dr Ashok Agarwal and the Chairman Dr S D Gupta. Dr Pankaj Gupta

• Team Building and individual fun games were developed for them.


