The MoU was signed through a virtual platform on 12 November 2020. The MoU is for the term of five years and will be valid till 31 December 2025.

This collaboration will provide a framework to facilitate research, capacity-building activities and exploring new research studies between SEARCH and IIHMR University.









Two significant programs starting early 2021

In continuation to our journey towards the expansion and growth of the University and developing leaders and managers for the health and development sector, we are happy to announce two new programs starting early 2021 based on the industry's felt need for middle and senior-level executives.



MBA (Executive) - Leadership & Strategy: The Master of Business Administration (Executive) in Leadership and Strategy, abbreviated as MBA (Executive) - L&S, is a two-year (4-semester) duration carefully crafted academic degree programme. The programme design is based on the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and Learning Outcome Based Curriculum Framework (LOCF) introduced by the University Grants Commission (UGC). The programme has been developed in line with the policy guidelines, suggested in NEP 2020 and offers excellent flexibility in terms of horizontal and vertical mobility through pragmatic credit transfer system. The degree also provides the multiple entry/ multiple exit option for executives who sometimes have time constraints.

Advanced Management Programme in Healthcare Leadership: AMP-HL is a 15-month duration modular programme, which focuses on executive leadership capacity building in healthcare management. The programme comprises seven modules, focusing on developing the competencies, required for effective healthcare leadership and management under fast-changing healthcare scenario. The programme is aligned to the MBA (Executive) -L&S programme of the University i.e., the participants will have the option to transfer programme credits if they want to earn an MBA (Executive) - L&S degree within three years from the completion of the AMP-HL programme (subject to meeting other eligibility criteria). The programme design is guided by the IIHMRU philosophy of research-driven knowledge co-creation and learning.



Innovative Virtual Field Interactions @ MBA Rural Management, SDS Field Work Segment I - Experiencing Rural Realties



Field segments are an essential part of the MBA Rural Management program. Due to travel restrictions in the current corona context, there was no way to visit and interact with villagers. An innovative approach in collaboration with reputed national CSOs facilitated a unique experiment on virtual field immersion. Two national repute organizations have come forward for this online field interactions/immersion in two regions' development contexts in India.

PRADAN, one of the largest CSO, takes students to Gumla block in Jharkhand. Moreover, with Manjari Foundation, the students get to engage with rural communities in Dholpur, Dausa, Ajmer, Bhilwara, Rajsamand, Chittorgarh in Rajasthan.

IIHMR celebrates its 36th Foundation Day on October 5, 2020

The Indian Institute of Health Management Research (IIHMR) celebrated the 36th Foundation Day on 5 October 2020 through an online platform witnessed by all faculty, staff, and students of IIHMR. Dr. Ashok Agarwal, Founder Trustee, IIHMR, made a significant announcement stating the IIHMR University will soon launch 'S D Gupta School of Public Health' in Jaipur. Dr. S.D. Gupta is the Trustee Secretary of Indian Institute of Health Management Research, and Chairperson of IIHMR University is a renowned public health specialist and has given a new shape to public health in India, said Dr. Agarwal.

Remembering the institute's initial foundation years, Dr. Agarwal said, "36 years back, we were trying to set up a new and different vision. I found a group of bright academicians who believed in my vision, and today IIHMR has three campuses in Jaipur, Bangalore and Delhi. The strength of IIHMR has been its faculty members. We have already done 800+ research studies and 3000 students' dissertations which is a significant contribution. Most of our graduates are dealing with COVID 19 as frontline workers, which makes us feel proud."

The program commenced with a small video displaying the history of IIHMR. The students of IIHMR University performed a much-awaited cultural program including Indian classical dance, song and poetry.

Dr. S. D. Gupta addressed the students and faculty online. Dr. Gupta said, "The institute has closely worked with the Government of India and other state governments in the management and execution of national health programs including the HIV control program, Immunization program and Blindness control program." Reminiscing the people behind this institute's formation, including Dr. Ashok Agarwal, Dr. Gupta said that Dr. Rameshwar Sharma, Dr. G. Girdhar, Dr. Udai Pareek, Dr. Rishikesh Maru, and Sh. M L Mehta has been the pillar of strength and their leadership has guided the institution to this level today.

Dr. P. R. Sodani, President (Officiating), IIHMR University, welcomed the guests and spoke about its vision and history and its courses in the present day. Dr. Sodani said, "we have successfully executed 35 years of excellence. Today we have created leadership in the domain area of health management in the country and globally. The institute was set up with a different vision. The country had many hospitals, but the hospitals' management remained a critical issue. There was an urgent need for an institute like IIHMR during that time. Even during COVID 19, it has been observed that the management of public health services is highly required. Initially, the institute's focus was research. Therefore, the initial years of IIHMR were spent in conducting research. Today we have created a space in the country as a renowned health management organization."


