# A BRIEF REPORT

The central Alumni Meet was followed by departmental alumni meetings where all the alumni interacted with their faculty members and junior students. The panel discussions brought together alumni experts to share their expertise and discuss important topics that are relevant to the industry. ### Points discussed in the Alumni meet with the Alumni are as follows:

## **Alumni Networking**

- A professional body of IIHMR alumnus (IIHMR Association) need to be formed immediately.
- All the alumni have suggested that the students must be interacted with the Alumni on regular basis, currently this is missing. They told that do not expect immediate success after passing out, and first three years of job must be given at the grass root level to understand the environment of development, different kind of challenges and how to manage them.
- The practical life at the corporate and government world is different. Hence, they suggested the students to be more practice than theoretical.
- Establish a robust network between students and alumni. Share List of alumni and their contact details with Alumni.

#### **Course Curriculum**

- Review Quality or Quantity in terms of starting courses.
- Blend of academic and practical classes (involvement of alumni for industry experience. Institute should cover their cost)
- More of case studies as the info is available on Google but insights would need expertise.
- Develop course content of your own and use the existing module for references.
- It was shared by the moderator that recently course curriculum has been revised by school in consultation with experts. More practical session is placed in the course and the university will try to match the same.
- However the alumni were of the opinion that the field segment is missing in course curriculum or conducted for short sphere. The alumni feels that necessary exposure related to the industry should be conduct for the Development management students. Lack of field exposure did not bring much confidence to the student, and they must involve in the field assignment rigorously at the grassroot level to understand the theory and practical work culture.
- Social and Developmental issue wise session must be conducted by experts and a student exchange programme must be conducted with industry. This need to be accelerated. The students must understand what kind of work is being done in the industry and whether they were skilled. Student should prioritise the operational area and must work in those domains since beginning.

## **Communication & Documentation, governance structure:**

- SDG has been focusing on publication for last so many years. It is important to inculcate this habit at the budding stage. Keep prize or medal for a student who is able to publish based on summer internship or dissertation.
- High emphasis should be given to communication and documentation, and how to manage the Human resources at organisational level. Project Management must have taught them rigorously with practical orientation. Besides, governance structure must be taught to them very prominently.
- Organisation and companies are focusing more on documentation. If student could be groom on those domain, chances of selection would be more. Multiple skill set should be developed among the students.

### Advance software and Analysis, Data presentation:

Developing Business. Research plan and conducting research is mandate in education, and this must be done
rigorously in summer internship and Dissertation. No relaxation should be given. More involvement from
industry experts in solving the problem will help them to understand the organisational culture.

### **Placement**

- To ensure interaction, necessary action must be conducted at a right timey the university. Students should be oriented towards how to manage the programmes at the field level.
- Initial salary will be less as students they do not know much about programme. So, students have to take lead for learning new things available on development sites. Research rigour need to be increase in teaching.
- Regular interaction must be conducted with Alumni in different places, and they may be called to give a lecture/session. The alumni are ready to help the students for placement, but the Development Management students need to be in touch with them on a prior basis for seeking their guidance.
- One piece of advice to students is to convert contact into connection.

To entertain and offer some moments of fun and frolic, the students of the university presented an exuberant cultural programme for the alumni including singing, dancing and acting performances followed by ramp walk by Esteemed Alumni and prize distribution to the winners of Ramp walk Mr. Alumni and Ms. Alumni. The event ended with the DJ evening and outdoor activities .

The Alumni Meet was a fruitful event, keeping up with the tradition of organizing an annual Alumni Meet in the university.
