Event details and Description:

On 26/04/2025, the team, led by Dr Nutan Jain, visited Shiv Shiksha Samiti, an established NGO in Tonk, Rajasthan. We began our journey at 8:00 AM and reached the organization's premises around 10:00 AM.

Upon arrival, the team was warmly received by the Director, along with other core team members. The session officially started with an Introduction round:

- MBA HHM students / gender champions, and the staff associated with Shiv Shiksha Samiti introduced themselves, sharing their names, educational backgrounds, and future aspirations.

Following the Introductions, the organization team shared a detailed History and background of Shiv Shiksha Samiti:

- Initially focused on Child rights training for local Accredited Social Health Activists (ANMs).
- Gradually expanded into affordable healthcare services, handling 30-40 deliveries per month with regular weekly doctor visits to support maternal and child health.
- Active programs on Women's empowerment, education, skill-building, and delaying early marriages were discussed.

After the Interactive session, we were taken on a guided tour of their facilities:

- Maternity Center: We visited the maternity ward where safe deliveries are conducted at low cost.
- Doctor's Room: A dedicated consultation room where patients are examined during weekly visits.
- Labour Room: Well-equipped space for safe childbirth.
- Small Pharmacy: An in-house pharmacy to dispense basic medicines and maternal care supplies.

- ANMs' Room: Accommodation and workspace provided for the Accredited Social Health Activists working with the NGO.

They also showed us their IEC (Information, Education, and Communication) materials, which are used to raise awareness in the community on health, hygiene, child rights, women's health, and education through posters, charts, and interactive tools.

Towards the end, the director elaborated on the mission and vision of Shiv Shiksha Samiti:

Mission: "Socio-economic empowerment of the marginalized and disadvantaged section of the society, especially women, through overall development of human and natural resources".

Vision: "Creation of an educated, healthy, and economically self-reliant society".

The visit concluded with an open discussion where we could share feedback, ask questions, and understand how each program interconnects to promote holistic community development. The entire experience was deeply inspiring, offering valuable insights into grassroots-level social work, healthcare management, and sustainable empowerment strategies.
