2. EVENT DETAILS

IIHMR University organised the second batch of the **International Training Program on Transformational Leadership for Health System Strengthening (TLHSS)** under the Indian Technical and Economic Cooperation (ITEC) Scheme of the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India, from June 29 to July 10, 2026. The programme was designed to strengthen leadership competencies and promote international collaboration in the area of health system strengthening.

The training programme brought together 19 healthcare professionals from nine countries, namely Belarus, Bhutan, Fiji, Kenya, Nepal, Sierra Leone, Sri Lanka, Tajikistan, and Tanzania. This international participation created a valuable platform for cross-country learning, exchange of experiences, and dialogue on global health systems and leadership practices.

Dr. P. R. Sodani, President, IIHMR University, Jaipur, inaugurated the programme and emphasized the importance of global partnerships, knowledge exchange, and visionary leadership in building resilient and sustainable health systems. His address set the context for the programme by underlining the need for transformative leadership in addressing contemporary health system challenges.

The programme featured multidisciplinary learning across health systems, health economics, healthcare analytics, Artificial Intelligence, implementation science, and leadership development. Through its diverse academic sessions and knowledge-sharing activities, the training programme aimed to enhance professional competencies and promote evidence-informed health system transformation.

It also reinforced the University's role as a platform for international training, collaborative learning, and leadership development in health systems strengthening.
