2. EVENT DETAILS

Dr. Nathaniel O. Brown, Director, Counseling Program and Assistant Professor, School of Education, Johns Hopkins University, Mount Washington Campus, visited IIHMR University, Jaipur from January 11 to January 15, 2026. During his visit, he met with Dr. P. R. Sodani, President, IIHMR University, Jaipur, and engaged with students, faculty, and staff through a series of academic and interactive sessions.

As part of the academic programme, Dr. Brown delivered a dedicated session on “Seeking Counselling: Early Alerts and Actions,” focusing on the importance of early identification of psychological distress, timely counselling support, and creating an enabling environment for student well-being. The session helped participants understand how early warning signs can be recognized and addressed through appropriate interventions and institutional support systems.

Dr. Brown also participated in multiple academic sessions where he shared his research experiences related to foster care, mental health issues, Vimukti, and school education research. These interactions provided valuable insights into contemporary counselling practices, mental health challenges among young people, and research-informed approaches to educational and psychosocial support.

In addition, he engaged in faculty interaction sessions on “Transformational Power of Mentoring” and “Multicultural Issues,” which facilitated rich dialogue on mentorship, diversity, inclusion, and culturally responsive counselling. Discussions were held to explore potential areas of academic and research collaboration between Johns Hopkins University and IIHMR University, further strengthening global academic engagement.

Beyond the formal academic schedule, Dr. Brown participated in cultural and experiential activities, including the Kite Flying Festival at Jal Mahal Lakeside and a Walled City tour in Jaipur. These engagements offered him an immersive experience of local heritage and culture and contributed to informal yet meaningful exchanges with the IIHMR community.

Overall, the visit was academically enriching and contributed to meaningful deliberations on counselling, mental health, and education research, while also reinforcing IIHMR University’s commitment to global collaboration and holistic student support.
