2. EVENT DETAILS

IIHMR University – Rajasthan Kshamta Kendra conducted a series of three-day **Induction Training Programmes for Peer Educator (PE) staff of Targeted Intervention (TI) Organisations** during July 2026. The programmes were designed to familiarise newly engaged TI staff with the operational framework, implementation processes, and service-delivery requirements of Targeted Intervention programmes. Two induction-training batches were conducted during the month. The first batch was held from **20th to 22nd July 2026** and included 19 Peer Educators from 13 Targeted Intervention Organisations. The second batch was held from **22nd to 24th July 2026** and included 21 Peer Educators from 14 Targeted Intervention Organisations. A total of 40 Peer Educators participated across the two July training batches.

The training aimed to strengthen participants' technical understanding of TI programme operations and improve their capacity to contribute effectively to programme implementation and service delivery. The sessions addressed the operational framework, implementation processes, coordination requirements, documentation, reporting, and field-level responsibilities associated with TI programmes.

The programme used a structured training approach to support role clarity and improve the readiness of Peer Educators working with different TI Organisations. Participants from various districts and organisations shared field-level experiences and gained an opportunity to learn from one another.

The programmes were coordinated by Dr. Ratna Verma and Ms. Mahima Purohit. Their coordination supported the systematic delivery of the training and ensured that participants received cadre-specific guidance relevant to their roles in Targeted Intervention programmes.

Overall, the Induction Training Programmes contributed to strengthening the capacity of Peer Educators and supported the effective implementation of TI services across Rajasthan.
