2. EVENT DETAILS

IIHMR University hosted a study tour of civil servants from the North-Eastern and Himalayan States and Union Territories as part of their Foundation Course at the Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration, Mussoorie, on July 7, 2026.

The visit was organised to familiarise the participating civil servants with IIHMR University's academic programmes, doctoral research, executive education, consultancy initiatives, and institutional activities in health management and allied areas. It provided the participants with an opportunity to understand the role of academic institutions in supporting evidence-based policymaking, public-sector capacity building, and effective administration.
