2. EVENT DETAILS

The Summer Internship Dissemination Workshop 2026 was organized by the School of Pharmaceutical Management, IIHMR University, on 10 July 2026 at the University campus in Jaipur. The workshop served as an important academic platform for MBA Pharmaceutical Management students to present the outcomes, key learnings, and professional experiences gained during their summer internships in the pharmaceutical and healthcare sectors.

During the workshop, students delivered structured presentations covering their internship objectives, major tasks undertaken, key findings, and reflections on organizational systems, processes, and industry practices. Faculty members from the School of Pharmaceutical Management evaluated the presentations, provided constructive feedback, and guided students on improving analytical depth, clarity of reporting, and professional communication.

The interaction reinforced the principles of experiential learning by encouraging students to connect classroom concepts with field-level realities, regulatory frameworks, market dynamics, and organisational strategies in pharmaceutical management. It also strengthened the integration of academic knowledge with industry practices by highlighting how theoretical tools, management frameworks, and analytical approaches can be applied to solve practical problems and support decision-making in pharmaceutical organisations.

The workshop created a collaborative environment in which students learned from each other's experiences across different organisations, locations, and functional areas such as marketing, supply chain, regulatory affairs, quality assurance, hospital pharmacy, and healthcare consulting. The academic deliberations helped students appreciate ethical practices, quality standards, patient-centric approaches, and compliance requirements in the broader pharmaceutical and healthcare ecosystem.

Overall, the Summer Internship Dissemination Workshop 2026 contributed to enhancing students' confidence, presentation skills, and readiness for future roles by providing formal academic recognition of their internship work and reinforcing outcome-based learning in the MBA Pharmaceutical Management programme.
