Background

Climate change is one of the most significant public health challenges of the twenty-first century, with rising temperatures, extreme weather events, air pollution, changing disease patterns, and environmental degradation increasingly affecting human health and health systems. Vulnerable populations, including children, older adults, women, and socioeconomically disadvantaged communities, are disproportionately affected.

This Online Certificate Programme is designed to build the capacity of public health professionals, healthcare managers, policymakers, development practitioners, researchers, and environmental professionals through an interdisciplinary approach covering climate science, environmental health, disaster risk reduction, climate-resilient health systems, climate policy, One Health, and sustainable development. The curriculum combines conceptual learning with case studies, simulations, expert sessions, and applied projects, enabling participants to develop practical solutions for climate-related health challenges.

Objectives



Develop a comprehensive understanding of climate science, environmental change, and their implications for public health.



Examine the health impacts of climate change on vulnerable populations, communities, and health systems.



Build competencies in climate risk assessment, vulnerability analysis, adaptation planning, and disaster risk reduction.



Strengthen knowledge of national and global climate policies, One Health, and climate-resilient health systems.



Enable participants to design evidence-based climate adaptation and mitigation strategies for improved public health outcomes.

Pedagogy

The programme adopts an interactive, learner-centered, competency-based, and practice-oriented approach that connects climate science with public health application. Participants learn through case studies, problem-based learning, group discussions, simulations, practical exercises, policy reviews, expert-led sessions, and guided self-learning, culminating in a capstone project focused on addressing real-world climate and health challenges within institutional or community settings.
